St. Catherine of Siena

Saint Catherine of Siena, a laywoman associated with the Dominican Order, was a Scholastic philosopher, and theologian who had a great influence on the Catholic Church. She is declared a saint and a doctor of the Church. Born in Siena, she grew up there and wanted very soon to devote herself to God, against the will of her parents. She joined the Sisters of the Penance of St. Dominic and made her vows. She made herself known very quickly by being marked by mystical phenomena such as stigmata and mystical marriage.

On Saturday, April 6th, our First Communicants gathered for "The Wonderful Picnic" Retreat. Children from CYF and School gathered, with their catechists and amazing group leaders, parent, and high school volunteers to hear the story of Jesus feeding thousands of people with a small gift from a little boy. They watched a movie about the sacrament of Holy Communion including how a community of sisters in Kentucky make hosts with flour and water in batches of 4500 at a time. They send their hosts to Parishes all over the U.S. The process takes more than a day to complete. They made their own host decorating it with symbols of Eucharist; wheat, grapes, a chalice, cross, dove, and many others. Then with their group they made unleavened bread and got to eat it at our Bread Sharing meal. Father Brian helped them understand the importance of receiving the Eucharist as often as they can and how we take Jesus with us everywhere we go and try our best to be like Him in everything we do and say. Father blessed their Communion pins, our Catechists practiced their meditation song, and we finished the morning with happy little First Communicates excited to receive Jesus for the first time on Saturday, May 11, 2019.
