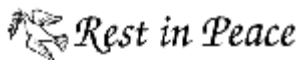

St. Catherine of Siena

Saint Catherine of Siena, a laywoman associated with the Dominican Order, was a Scholastic philosopher, and theologian who had a great influence on the Catholic Church. She is declared a saint and a doctor of the Church. Born in Siena, she grew up there and wanted very soon to devote herself to God, against the will of her parents. She joined the Sisters of the Penance of St. Dominic and made her vows. She made herself known very quickly by being marked by mystical phenomena such as stigmata and mystical marriage.

Al served as a Youth Minister for six years at St. Charles Borromeo Parish in Milwaukee, and six years as Director of Religious Education at Sacred Heart Parish in Racine. Pastoral Council Members

Beginning on April 27th 2019 nominations will be open for four (4) Pastoral Council members. This is a 3 year term. Nominees need to be baptized, practicing Catholics at least 18 years old and registered members of the parish. Parishioners are invited to write down the names of persons they feel are council candidates – **this can be themselves**. Nominees will be contacted by the selection committee with orientation and time commitment information. The discernment to the Pastoral Council will take place on May 28th. The Council nomination forms will be available in the pews from May 4th through May 19th.

Current Pastoral Council members will speak at the masses on May 4 – 5 and May 11 – 12.

Parish Trustee Treasurer

Fr. Brian Holbus is giving notice to SCB parishioners that the election process for the Trustee Treasurer has begun with the election to be held on June 8 - 9, 2019. An election committee has been established to carry out the election. The parish Trustee Treasurer must be a baptized, practicing Catholic at least 25 years old and a registered member of the parish. The Trustee Treasurer is a member of the Parish Corporation Board, who participates in Trustee meetings, Finance Council meetings and Pastoral Council meetings.

Fr. Brian may identify a nominee for this position. Additional candidates must be nominated in writing by 10 or more registered parish members. Forms are available in the Parish Office and must be completed and returned by 1:00 PM on May 24th 2019. If there is only one nominee at that time, that person is declared elected to the position. If there are more than one nominee, the candidates' names will be announced 2 weeks prior to the election. Parish members at least 18 years old are eligible to vote.

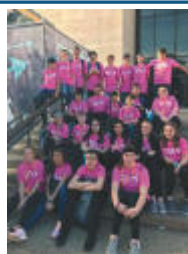
