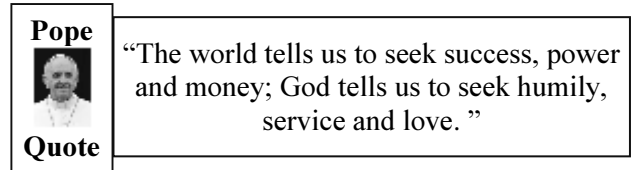

Pastoral Council Nomination forms are available in the pews. Please fill one out and drop them in the designated box in the back of church or give them to one of the ushers. Nominees need to be baptized, practicing Catholics at least 18 years old and registered members of the parish. Nominees will be contacted by the selection committee with orientation and time commitment information. The discernment to the Pastoral Council will take place on May 28th

The nomination process for the **Trustee Treasurer** position is in progress. Candidates must be nominated in writing by 10 or more registered parish members. The parish Trustee Treasurer must be a baptized, practicing Catholic at least 25 years old and a registered member of the parish. Forms are available in the Parish Office or in the back of the church. They must be completed and returned to the Parish Office by 3PM on May 24th.

For new families to our Parish ~ Who Should Register?

CYF Catholic Youth Formation

- All Parish students attending Public Schools in grades 1 – 10 All new students to the CYF program must include a copy of the student's baptismal certificate.

Sacrament Preparation:

- **First Reconciliation & Eucharist:** Children in 2nd grade or those that have not received First Reconciliation or First Eucharist, both in our Parish School and CYF Classes are to register for First Reconciliation & First Eucharist as this is a Parish-Based sacrament prep program.
- **Rite of Christian Initiation for Children:** – A child of catechetical age that has not been baptized, received formal religion classes, or has been baptized in another faith tradition should enroll. Catechetical age is considered to be the age of 7 or older.
- **Confirmation:** All Parish students both in Public and Catholic high schools in 11th grade are to register for immediate Confirmation Preparation.

Students already in our Programs: All students already in our programs have received sacrament registration information along with their CYF registrations. Students in the School were sent Sacrament Registration information through school. Students that attend Catholic High Schools have been sent registration information to your home.

Note: Anyone interested in registering for sacrament preparation must have completed the prerequisite of Christian Formation preparation prior to immediate preparation for the sacraments.

Note: Confirmation & Sacrament Prep registrations must include a copy of the student's baptismal certificate.

RCIA-Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

The Church welcomes all who come through our doors and encourages those that have not been baptized or catechized, or may have been baptized in another faith tradition and now desire receive the sacraments of initiation to join our RCIA process. 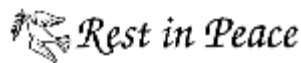
