

2019-2020 Registration is now being taken. For new families to our Parish ~ Who Should Register?

#### **CYF Catholic Youth Formation**

• All Parish students attending Public Schools in grades 1 - 10 All new students to the CYF program must include a copy of the student's baptismal certificate.

#### **Sacrament Preparation:**

- **First Reconciliation & Eucharist:** Children in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or those that have not received First Reconciliation or First Eucharist, both in our Parish School and CYF Classes are to register for First Reconciliation & First Eucharist as this is a Parish-Based sacrament prep program.
- Rite of Christian Initiation for Children: A child of catechetical age that has not been baptized, received formal religion classes, or has been baptized in another faith tradition should enroll. Catechetical age is considered to be the age of 7 or older.
- Confirmation: All Parish students both in Public and Catholic high schools in 11<sup>th</sup> grade are to register for immediate Confirmation Preparation.

<u>Students already in our Programs:</u> All students already in our programs have received sacrament registration information along with their CYF registrations. Students in the School were sent Sacrament Registration information through school. Students that attend Catholic High Schools have been sent registration information to your home.

<u>Note:</u> Anyone interested in registering for sacrament preparation must have completed the perquisite of Christian Formation preparation prior to immediate preparation for the sacraments.

<u>Note</u>: Confirmation & Sacrament Prep registrations must include a copy of the student's baptismal certificate.

#### RCIA-Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

The Church welcomes all who come through our doors and encourages those that have not been baptized or catechized, or may have been baptized in another faith tradition and now desire receive the sacraments of initiation to join our RCIA process. 


