## Parish & Community News



My name is Fr. Carlos Alberto Zapata, and I'm from Colombia.

I am from a huge family which includes my father and mother, three sisters and four brothers. I have one nephew and ten nieces along with two grandnephews and three grandnieces. My family is very close to me and are my biggest supporters for my vocation, especially my mom and one of my sisters, who is a Franciscan nun in Colombia. In April 2000, I lost my brother (two years older than me) and on January 6 2019, (Epiphany Day), I lost my mom. My 89 year old father is currently in Home Hospice Care.

I graduated in Philosophy and Theology from the Augustine Community Seminary in Colombia. I left the community and for 10 years I was working as a high school teacher. Always in my heart I have felt the call of God.

In January 2008, I arrived in the United States. I studied English as a second language at the Sacred Heart School of Theology and at UW Milwaukee as a Seminarian of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. In 2010 I did my internship at St Charles Parish in Hartland and in 2011 I finished my CPE, (Clinic Pastoral Education), at St Camillus Nursing Home in Milwaukee. On November 4th, 2011, (St Charles Borromeo's feast day), I was ordained as a Deacon by Bishop Donald High at St Francis De Sales Seminary. It was the first ordination for him as a Bishop. On May 19th, 2012, I was ordained as a Priest along with 5 classmates at St. John Evangelist Cathedral in Milwaukee.

My first assignment was at St Clement and Holy Name of Jesus Parishes in Sheboygan for 4 years. My second assignment was at St. Adalbert, St Vincent De Paul and Prince of Peace in Milwaukee for 1 year. My third assignment was at St. Charles Borromeo, St. Mary and St Joseph parishes in Burlington for 2 years and now my new assignment is here at St Charles Borromeo and St Roman Parishes in Milwaukee. I have a great connection with St. Charles Borromeo as he is one of my favorite saints in my spiritual life.

I am far away from my family, but very happy for my answer to God's call and for my life now with all of you. You are my family as well, my community and I'm very happy to share my faith with all of you, especially, the Eucharist. Finally, on behalf of my family I would like to say to all of you: thank you for this opportunity, for your prayers, and for your friendly welcome to me.

Thanks to Fr. Brian Holbus, my friend, for your support. I am what I am today thanks to God and to Father Brian. I am very glad to work with you.

Finally, thank you everybody for your prayers for all of us and for all our seminarians, because Jesus said: "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few: pray you therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth laborers into his harvest." Lc. 10,2.

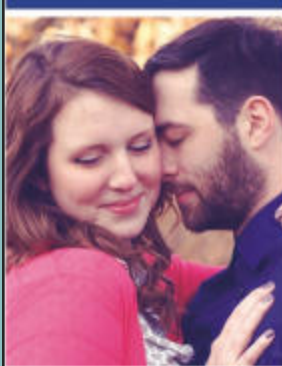
