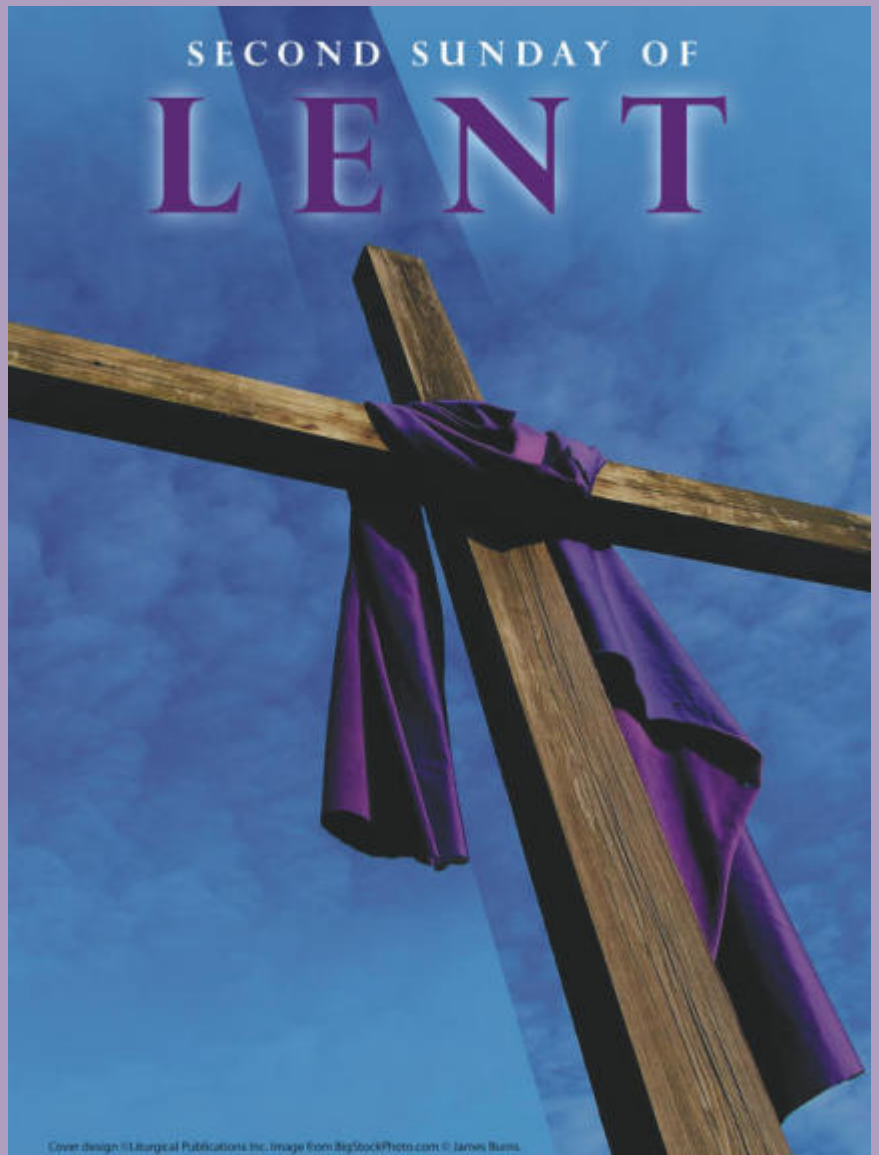

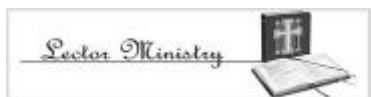

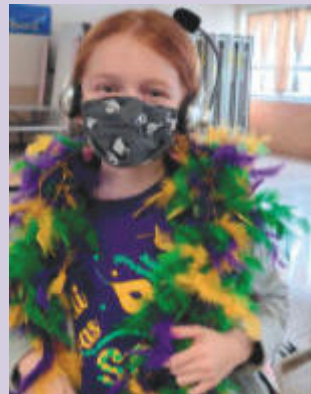
SCB Mardi Gras Celebration
