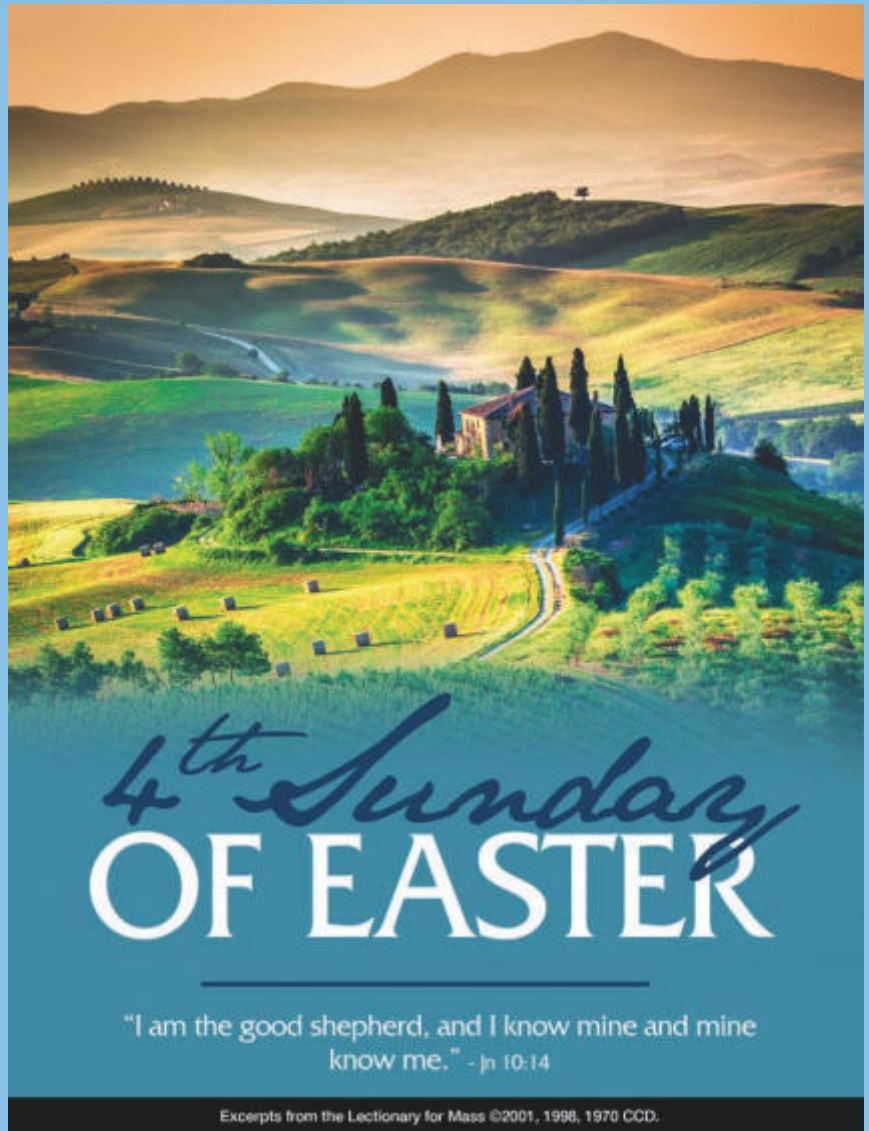

Human Concerns Commission Monthly Outreach – April 2021

The Human Concerns Commission Outreach donation for April 2021 was made to Kathy's House. Kathy's House is a hospital guest house that provides affordable lodging and support for families who need to travel to Milwaukee for medical care. Kathy's House is the only hospital guest house that serves patients of all ages and their caregivers, serving all Milwaukee area hospitals. A referral from a health care professional is required.



Kathy's House helps families—including those in financial hardship—access needed health care and stay together during a medical crisis. For many families, the costs associated with staying in even a moderately-priced hotel are out of reach. 40 percent of their patient guests would not have been able to access the care they need without Kathy's House.
