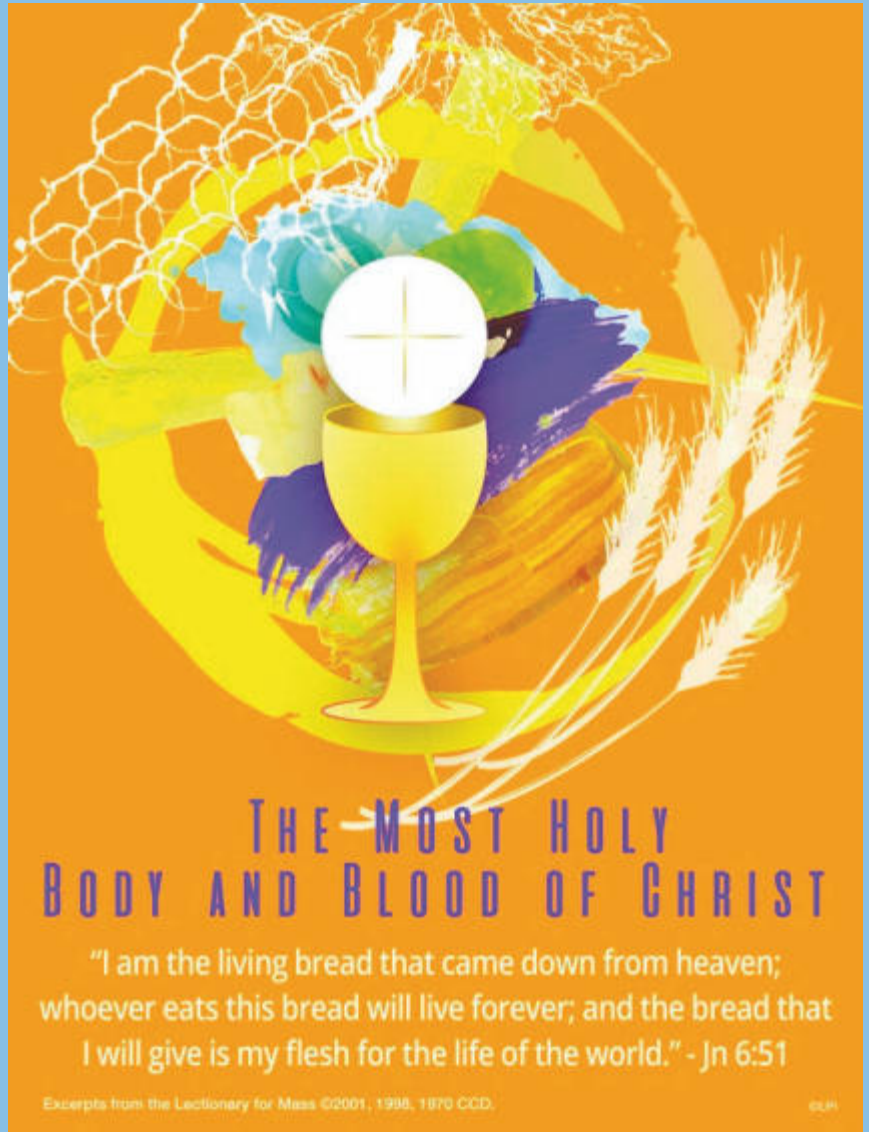

Update on Social Distancing/Masks

In accordance with the Archdiocese matrix and the City of Milwaukee, and with suggestions from Pastoral Council, please see the following updates, effective June 12:

- ◇ Tape on the east (St. Joseph) side of the church will be removed; social distancing and masks will not be required.
- ◇ Alternate pews on the west (Mary) side will remain in effect. When you sit on this side of the church, masking and social distancing will be required.
- ◇ The priests and Eucharistic ministers, if they are vaccinated, will not be required to wear masks.
- ◇ Hand sanitizing stations will remain in place throughout the church.
- ◇ Communion will continue down the side aisles.
- ◇ Fogging after all events will continue.
