Catholic Youth Formation Program News **2021/2022 Registration Now Open** **Who Should Register?**



CYF Catholic Youth Formation:

All Parish students attending non-Catholic elementary or high school in grades 4K– 10th Grade.

Sacrament Preparation:

First Reconciliation & Eucharist: Children in 2nd grade or those that have not received First Reconciliation or First Eucharist, both in our parish school and CYF classes, are to register for these sacraments, as this is a parish-based sacrament preparation program.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Children: A child of catechetical age that has not been baptized, received formal religion classes, or has been baptized in another faith tradition should enroll. Catechetical age is considered to be the age of 7 or older.

Confirmation: All Parish students both in Public and non-Catholic high schools in 11th grade are to register for immediate Confirmation Preparation.

RCIA– Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

The Church welcomes all who come through our doors and encourages those that have not been baptized or catechized, or may have been baptized in another faith tradition and now desire to receive the sacraments of initiation, to join our RCIA process. Inquiry sessions for Adults are forming now.

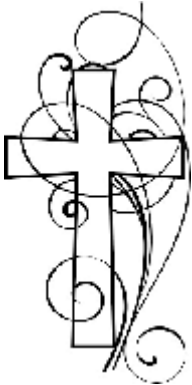
Baptism Class
