Joyfully, St. Charles Borromeo Parish would like to announce that it has received a \$20,000 grant from the Catholic Community Foundation. This grant will provide updates to the kitchen and allow for the installation of two new furnaces and air conditioning in the cafeteria/hall.

We are humbled and very grateful for this incredible support to SCB. As St. Charles Borromeo Parish celebrated our 60th anniversary amidst the pandemic, it became increasingly apparent the need within our parish and greater community to make sure we can have adequate kitchen equipment and community gathering areas with improved ventilation. This grant will help fund the start of this endeavor. We hope that in the future more improvements can be made with additional funds.

We have begun some of these updates already. Installation of new refrigeration units for the kitchen occurred this summer. We will be working on the updated bids for the furnace and air condition and will have this work completed in the fiscal year. Sometimes wishes do come true!
