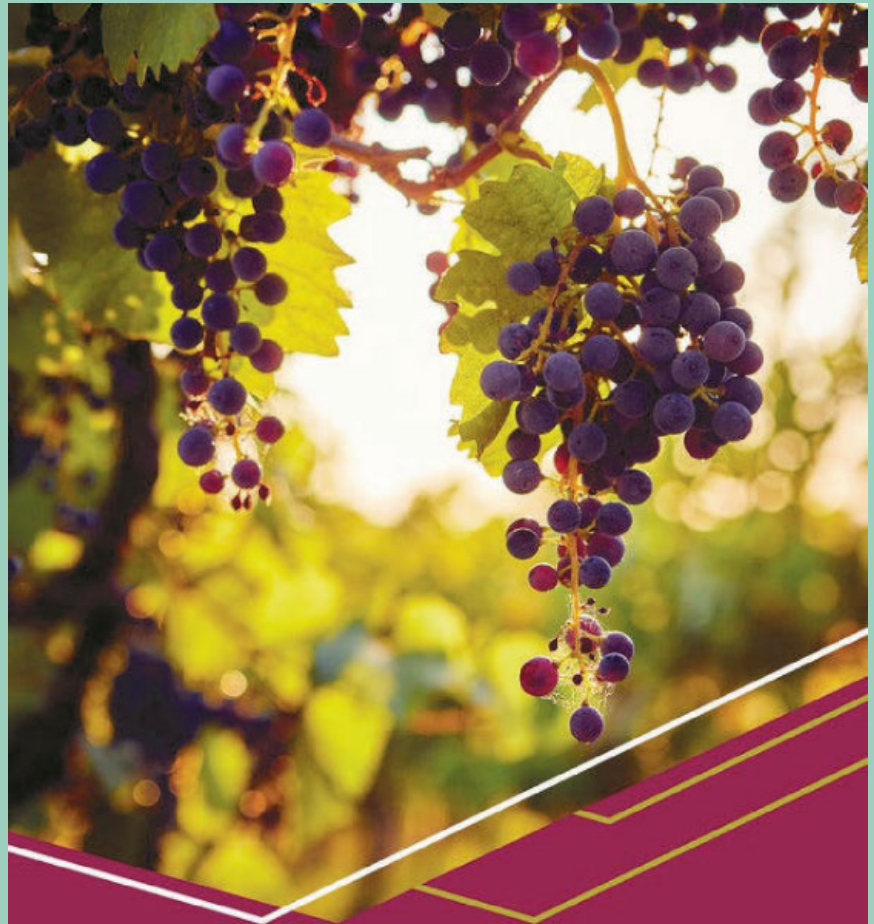

Dinner and Wine Tasting

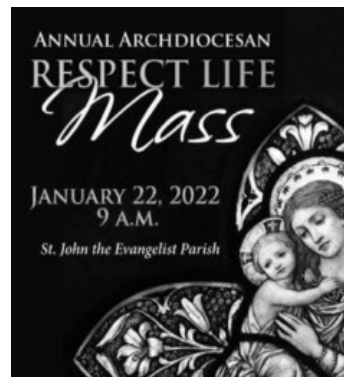

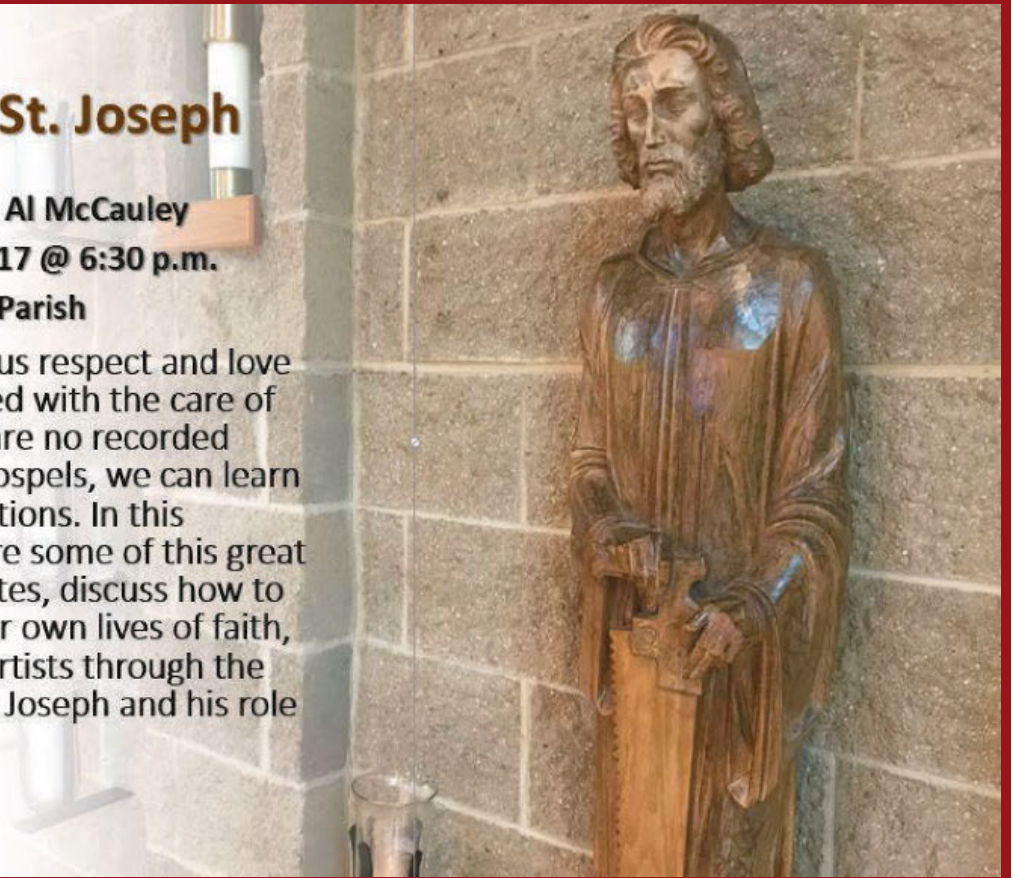
