Staff Reflection-Real Presence

After last week's reading of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes, today we hear how the crowd followed Jesus across the Sea of Galilee into Capernaum looking for more! Yes, they were physically nourished with the bread and fish, but deep down, they were seeking to fill a deeper hunger in their souls. Jesus points this out to them when he says "do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you." How do we get this nourishment? Simply by believing IN Jesus! God asks that we commit ourselves totally and unconditionally to his will. When we believe IN something, it is more than just lip service, it's an investment. It is an act of faith and trust and letting go of worldly obsessions to make room for the Bread of Life.

The song "Bread of Life" was instrumental in my formation as a teen. The verses in this song come straight from the Gospel of John. I belonged to a guitar/folk group at St. Anthony's in Menomonee Falls along with several of my classmates. One year a college student joined us for the summer and introduced us to this song. (Yes, it's been around that long!) Jeff was very spiritual, and instead of just teaching us the music, he studied the verses and words with us. I remember him talking about this song is what makes us unique in the Christian world as it was about our Catholic belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The last verse goes like this:

Yes Lord, I believe that you are the Christ

The Son of God, who has come into the world.

We would slow down at this verse and emphasize "I believe."

A 2019 survey published that only 1/3 of Catholics believe in the Real Presence. I think it is sad that so many Catholics do not believe that the Eucharist is the Bread of Life. This is so critical, that the USCCB is launching a three-year Eucharistic Revival beginning in the summer of 2022. The bishops are asking the beginning in June of 2022 dioceses across America will hold Eucharistic events. I am sure that we will be getting more information from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.

We don't need to wait until 2022. We can begin today to take seriously our personal relationship with the Eucharist. Jesus invites us to come to His table, to find nourishment for that which our soul is seeking, to grow in our faith as we learn to love like Jesus and to share what we have learned with others.

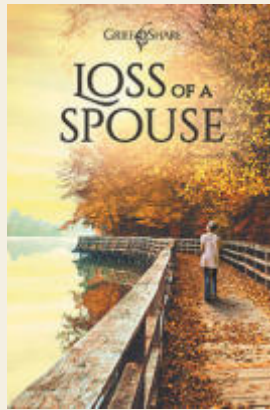
