

Take some time this week to recognize the people in your life who are doing well. Tell them so.

No matter what the relationship or situation, we are all walking together, working toward a common goal. Be inclusive and be open to God's Spirit in your life. God calls *all of us* to his mission; yes, even THAT guy. Will you accept the challenge to selflessly walk with one another?

"Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing" (1 Thessalonians 5:11).


