“For whoever is not against us is for us” (Mark 9:40).

Our readings this weekend speak to the question of inclusion and exclusion in the work of God’s kingdom. Who is invited to speak and act in God’s name?



There is often the temptation to limit others’ actions in an attempt to maintain control and influence. After all, things become unpredictable when they are out of our hands; unpredictability can be scary and unsettling. Jesus reminds us in the Gospel that the Spirit of God cannot be limited or controlled. In fact, any attempt to control the workings of the Spirit is in direct violation of our mission as Disciples of Christ. Our task as disciples is to be open to God’s will and respond in a way that furthers the work of God’s kingdom, not hinder it. We need to let go of *our* desire to control and let *God* guide our actions. This is step one.

Once we allow the Spirit to move freely in our hearts, the next step is to accept our challenge to lift others up and encourage them for the good work that they are doing for God. Sometimes we hold back encouragement and praise because we fear that, by building others up, we will look less important or less productive or less successful. God’s kingdom isn’t about “me” or “self.” God’s kingdom is a cooperative, others-centered mission and it can only be achieved through genuine love and support for our fellow disciples. If we are all FOR the kingdom of God, then we cannot be AGAINST one another.

These are good reminders for *all* of our relationships in life—co-workers, family members, friends, co-ministers in our parish work, etc. Through our words and actions, are we building up the people around us or are we being stingy with praise and compliments? Take some time this week to recognize the people in your life who are doing well. Tell them so.

No matter what the relationship or situation, we are all walking together, working toward a common goal. Be inclusive and be open to God’s Spirit in your life. God calls *all of us* to his mission; yes, even THAT guy. Will you accept the challenge to selflessly walk with one another?

“Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing” (1 Thessalonians 5:11).

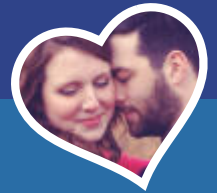

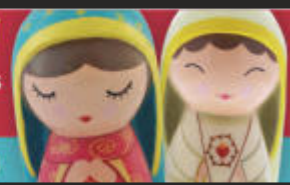
