“Notes” from your music and liturgy director....

Greetings and Happy New Year to you all! I know we are a few weeks into January but it’s a time for new beginnings and fresh starts! Although I did chuckle when someone last week told me a funny saying...."A New

Year's resolution is something that goes in one year and out the other." Hopefully we are all still trying, one step at a time!

To help us along with changes in our lives...we have to have a plan. The best resolutions begin with a written plan. We find Jesus’ plan for all of us in the scriptures. In this Sunday’s Gospel from Luke, the words read by Jesus say: “The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He has anointed me. “ In the immediate sense, we know that Jesus really was anointed by the Holy Spirit when he was baptized by John in the Jordan River. But in the long-term sense, Jesus wants us to know that the same Spirit has anointed us as well.

When Jesus gave us the Great Commandment—to love God and to love one another—he was telling us to follow His example. He was telling us to go and set people free. He was urging us to hear and respond to the cry of the poor. He was asking us to be as concerned with people who are in need as we are with our relationship with Him.

We at Seton are so blessed to have so many disciples involved in so many different outreach activities. There are many opportunities that we all can be involved with. A couple weeks ago Pastor James West from Repairers of the Breach spoke about all the people who need help, and how we can make a difference. I was truly moved by his compassion and dedication to humankind, to make the impossible, possible.

Last Sunday I was struck by what Fr. Dave Filut spoke about during his homily. He said this time between Christmas and Easter, this time between the cradle and the cross, this journey from Bethlehem to Jerusalem, how are we challenged? How can we change our lives to be more like Jesus.

The challenge can seem overwhelming. Nonetheless, if each one of us could add an hour or two every month to answer the Lord’s call, that would mean an increase of thousands of hours, Imagine the joy it would give Jesus to see all his people taking their spiritual anointing seriously and serving one another! “Here I am, Lord. You have anointed me, and I want to serve.”

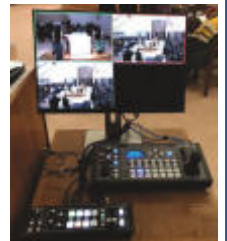
SOUND AND VIDEO MINISTRY
