### When were you baptized? Where

were you baptized? Please be careful because these are trick questions. In our Catholic Faith, we have seven sacraments. For reasons I do not fully understand, we have come to think of our sacraments as MAGIC MOMENTS. We even speak of them this way. We say, "On this day I was baptized." Or "On this day I made my first communion or I was confirmed." What always throws me is when someone will say, "On this day I received the Sacrament of Matrimony." Many people instead will say, "On such and such a day I was married." The latter statement is more accurate. Because on your wedding day, you are BEGINNING marriage. On your wedding day, you do not receive the Sacrament of Matrimony, you are beginning to LIVE the Sacrament of Matrimony.

Holy Orders is another of our seven sacraments. Do vou think I received the Sacrament of Holy Orders on the day I was ordained a Catholic Priest? I really do not think so. On that day I began to receive that Sacrament by trying to live it. When I was ordained, I had an older brother who was a bit of a philosopher. I will never forget that, after the First Mass and the big dinner and reception, we were relaxing in our parents' living room and my brother said to me, "Joe, you are now a priest. But you don't act like a priest, you don't talk like a priest, you don' think like a priest. Maybe someday that will come!" Wow! That really knocked me over and I still remember that quite clearly. He was absolutely correct. I do not know if I have fully grown into this sacrament yet. Maybe someday that will come.

So back to BAPTISM. Again it is not just a water ceremony. Baptism is not a magic moment when someone pours water over our heads. It is a daily walking with the Lord Jesus and forming our thoughts, our values, our words, our actions in the ways of Jesus as our Savior and Christ. So are you baptized? Please think about this. Please keep working on this as well.
