

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED! NDSM AFTERSCHOOL SNACK PROGRAM IS BACK!

After almost a two-year hiatus of Seton's involvement with providing snacks for the NDSM middle school girls' after school program, Seton is bringing this effort back for the remainder of the school year. And we are asking for your **HELP**!

The program:

After the regular school day, the students are required to participate in afterschool activities such as educational and athletic programs or tutoring assistance. During their break they receive a snack before they attend the planned activities. Our goal is to provide healthy individually sized snacks for **175 students per day three times a week** for the next five months or 57 days. We are looking for parish members that are interested in donating snacks for one of those day.




