"Thoughts On Prayer"

Recently I came across a small book on prayer by Rev. Robert Faricy entitled Praying. Since I have previously written that prayer is very efficacious in strengthening relationships, I thought that with his help I would dwell longer on the topic. True prayer is not just rattling off a set vocal prayer like the Our Father. It goes much deeper than that. Would you meet up with a friend and recite a section of the Gettysburg Address to them as a greeting? That would be terribly impersonal. We need to get personal with God. In his opening paragraph Fr. Faricy reminds us that "Christian praying is in and through Jesus In Jesus, God reaches out to us, calling us to respond. That response is to be in Jesus, to abide in Jesus." Abiding is not a two minute act; it is a continuous movement. However, it is not achieved overnight. It takes time and perseverance. It is achieved by a conscious turning to the Lord until it becomes habitual. It is a sharing of one's self with the Lord by whom we know ourselves to be loved.
