Toward A Contemporary Understanding Of Jesus

What should be the starting point for a contemporary understanding of Jesus? Perhaps we should go back to the time Jesus actually walked on the earth? If we go to the 4 gospels, however, we need to keep in mind that the earliest of them was really written at least 20 years after Jesus died. Biblical scholars believe they are not so much historical writings as "faith" ones. Reflecting the understandings of the early church, they were written according to the rules for biographies (economics) at that time. (The present rules for writing historical documents only evolved in the 1800's.) In addition, each gospel has a different understanding of how the divinity and humanity of Jesus played out in every day circumstances. The earliest, Mark's gospel, emphasizes more the humanity of Jesus while the latest, John's, more the divinity. Study them carefully and see if you agree.
