

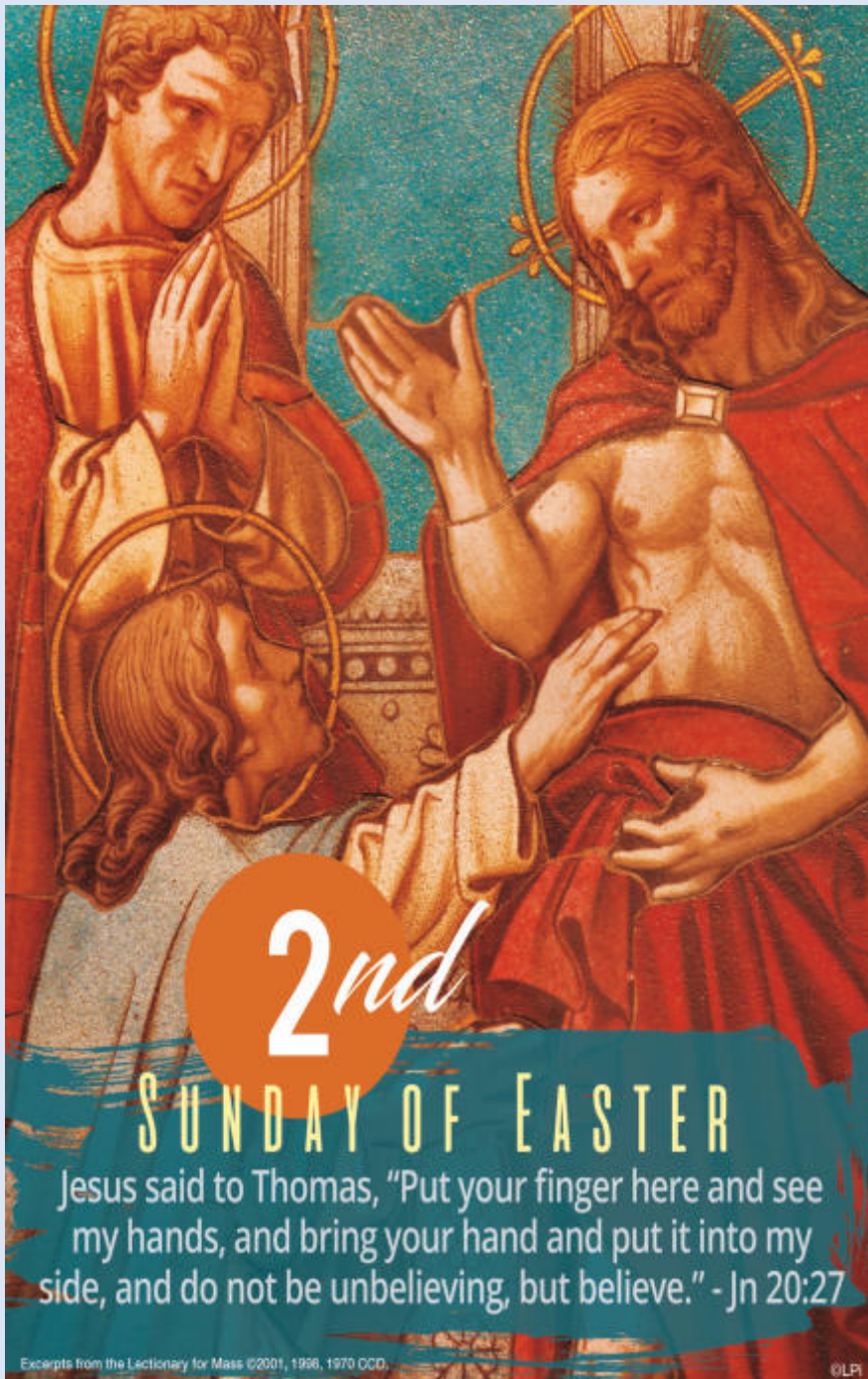

Why Did Jesus Die On The Cross?

A number of contemporary theologians disagree with Anselm's theory. S. Elizabeth Johnson, professor emeritus of Fordham U., for example, believes that Jesus' death was the consequence of the kind of ministry He practiced. She questions interpretations of His death as a payment for sin saying that they can lead to portrayals of God as an angry, violent father. She considers the crucified Jesus to be the presence of God descending into the depths of human pain and suffering. Speaking of the Resurrection, she states in one of her books, *She Who Is*, "Her (God's) pure, beneficent, people-loving Spirit seals Him in new unimaginable life as pledge of a future for all the violated and the dead." Further in the same book, S. Elizabeth concludes that the resurrection discloses that Jesus suffering was "neither passive, useless, nor divinely ordained, but is linked to the ways of God in forging peace and justice in an antagonistic world."

The mini-course "Understanding Jesus through the Centuries" will conclude this coming Monday, Apr. 29th, with brief looks at liberation theology and Christ in the cosmos. Both strains of thought will help you better understand the thinking of our current pontiff, Pope Francis.
