FROM THE ARCHIVES

Did you know?

John Van Hengel, a native of Waupun, set up the nation's first food bank in Phoenix, Arizona in 1967. John was born in Waupun in 1923. He was the son of a nurse and the town's pharmacist. After graduating from Lawrence University, with a government degree, he moved to California and later Phoenix.

In the mid-60's, looking for purpose to his life, John found himself talking to a woman who had 10 children and a husband on death row. For all her hardships, she said food was no problem. The woman explained that she shopped in the garbage bins at the rear of a nearby grocery store. Mr. Van Hengel went to the bins and found food that was still packaged and frozen, loose carrots, and bread. The woman had healthy children and they seemed to eat well. John then visited the store manager who took him to a back room where he found other things being thrown out like a case of catsup with one broken bottle, and cans with dents. He asked if he could have the discarded items and the manager said yes. John then began making the rounds of many stores.

John had found his purpose in life. He began organizing surplus food and distributing it to people in need. He called it Saint Mary's Food Bank. By 1976 John received some grant money and the project was renamed Second Harvest. The name came from the biblical story of Ruth, who gleaned grain left by reapers.

In 2005 John Van Hengel died at the age of 83. He was buried in Waupun's Calvary cemetery. The front of his tombstone reads:

JOHN VAN HENGEL

FEB 21, 1923 - OCT 5, 2005

THE FATHER OF FOOD BANKING

The back of his stone states his life's mission:

**THE POOR WE SHALL ALWAYS HAVE WITH US,
BUT WHY THE HUNGRY?**
