

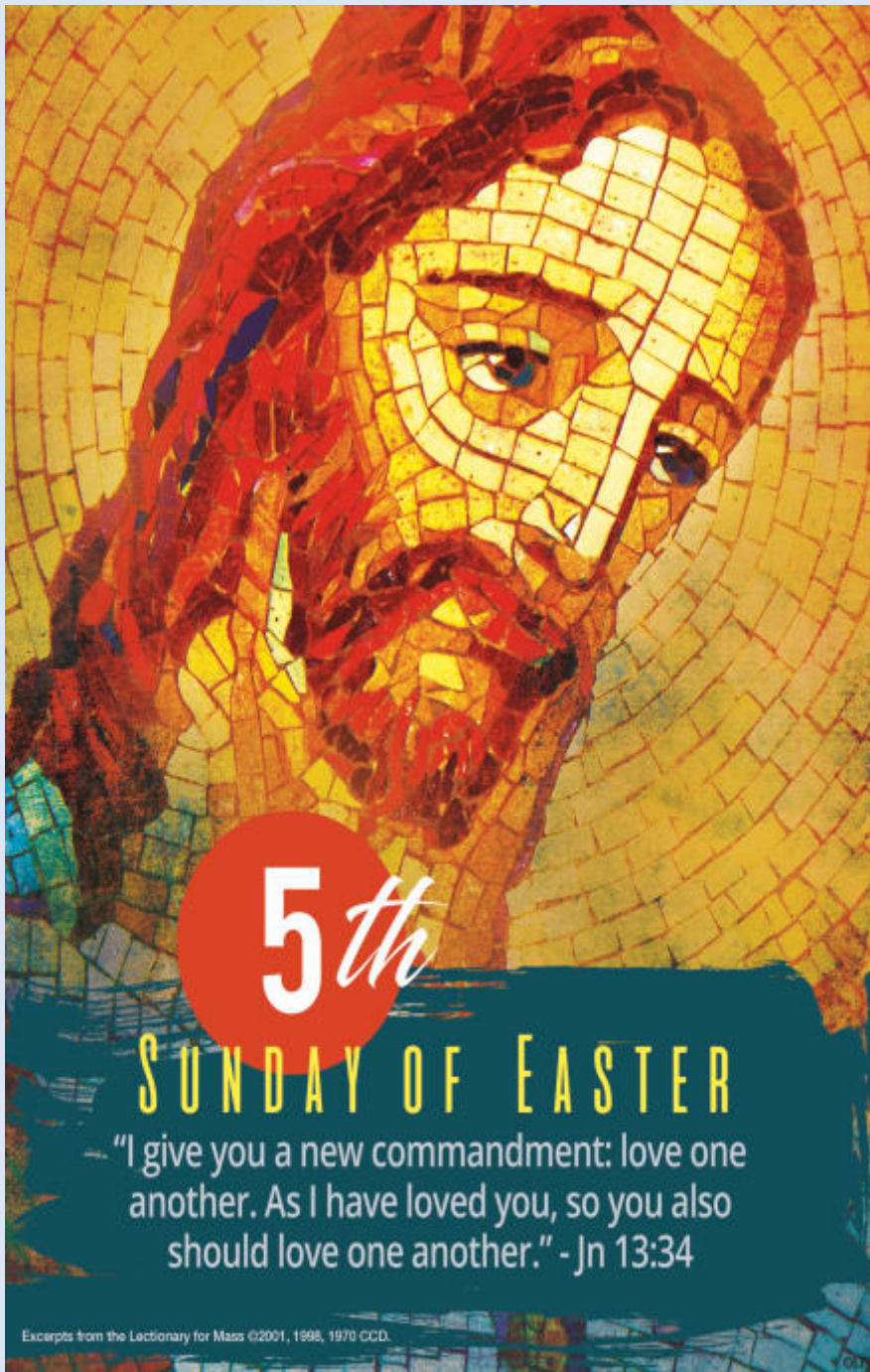

What I Would Say To The Pope

The commission on women deacons has handed its partial conclusion to the pope who, in turn, has asked the members to continue their study individually. At a recent meeting of the International Union of Superiors General (USIG) Pope Francis handed them a copy saying, "We must study this I cannot make a sacramental decree without a theological, historical foundation."

Terrribly disappointed in the initial outcome, the first idea that sprang to mind was one I had learned from Fr. Neyrey's lectures on Jesus' culture. Jesus lived in a "verbal" culture. The implications would make it difficult at times to find written records. Also, there is a time gap of at least 20 years between Jesus' life and the time that it was finally written down. On Saturday I was dusting the books in my living room. Opening at random Women Shaping Church History, I found this surprising paragraph: the Apostolic Constitutions, a fourth-century document, describes a ceremony for ordaining women deaconesses. When the bishop laid hands on a woman, he was to pray, "Do Thou look down on this Thy servant, who is to be ordained to the office of woman deacon and grant her Thy Holy Spirit." The paragraph further adds: "Later councils forbade the practice of ordaining women as deacons." Numerous reasons were given.
