#### Merry Christmas!

The end of the Season of Christmas arrives this Sunday as we celebrate the event that marked the end of Jesus' early life and the beginning of His public ministry: His baptism. Starting next week, we'll begin to hear about Christ's ministry and mission, before we enter into the season of Lent in 2 months. Traditionally the Christmas season lasted until February 2nd with the Feast of the Presentation, 40 days after the birth of Christ when according to Jewish tradition, the first born child was presented in the temple. So if you are looking for an excuse to leave up your Christmas trees and take time sending out thank you cards - this is your excuse.

Our theme throughout our Scripture passages this week is the expansion of the Covenant. The Prophet of Isaiah talks about how God is preparing Israel to be a light to the nations, a light that will be shared with those gentiles who in the past had lived in darkness. St. Peter says that the New Covenant has been expanded to allow even the Gentiles to enter into it - that Jesus is Lord of All. How do we enter into this covenant? We do it by being baptized into Christ. So the Covenant is no longer limited just to those who could trace their lineage to the Twelve Tribes of Jacob, but to anyone who gives their heart to the Lord through the Sacrament of Baptism.

I was absent this past weekend, because I had a positive COVID test. It was two nights of chills, one night of mucus, and a fever throughout. I spent most of my time laying by the fire either napping or watching TED talks on youtube. If you hear any cool examples in my homilies, it will be the fruit of my quarantine. Thank you to everyone who prayed for me and offered to drop off food as I was quarantining in the rectory. We all need family both to receive love when we are in need as well as to give love when others are in need - be sure to check in on your relatives this week.

The start of the new year is oftentimes when people make resolutions to live better lives, we take up habits that make our lives healthier physically, but I would also like us to ask what actions will we take to live a life that is healthier spiritually. I'll be going for a 20 minute walk each day as I call up friends and family. What steps will you take this year so that you'll be the best version of yourself this time next year? Don't worry that we are already a big chunk into January, it's never a bad time to take those steps to become more fully who God calls you to be. The best time to plant a tree is 30 years ago, the second best time is today.
