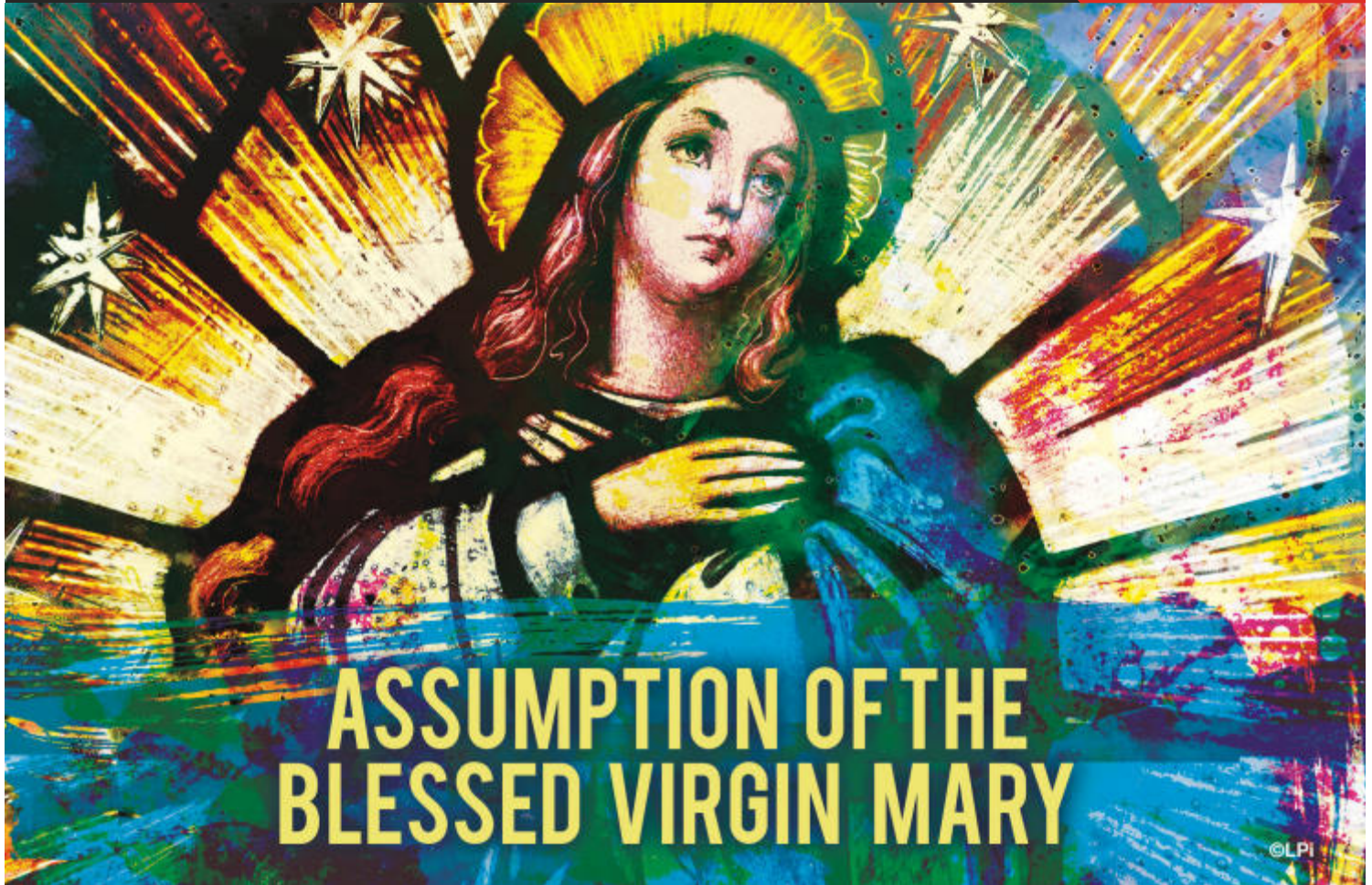

The office is open Monday-Friday from 8am to 4:30pm.

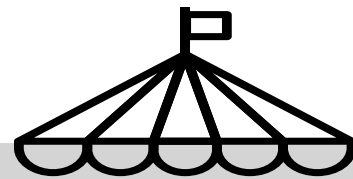
Respect Life Committee

Leadville is the location of the tallest steeple in the United States at 11,000 feet. **Annunciation Catholic Church** calls the 3,000lb bell installed in 1885 “St. Mary”. Inside the church at 609 Poplar St. are wall-sized murals filled with Slovene folk art. (holymfamilyleadville.com)

Facts for Faithful Kids

1. August 18, 1774 is the birthday of Meriwether Lewis, an American explorer. In June 1803, President Thomas Jefferson asked Lewis to begin a journey to explore the new territory of the US called the Louisiana Purchase. Lewis and William Clark led a band of 33 men from Missouri to the Pacific Ocean shore in what is now Washington State and back again. They were the first Americans to reach this coast. Would you like to be an explorer and learn new things about the world God made?

2. August 19 is National Aviation day. It was also the birthday of Orville Wright. Orville and his brother Wilbur built the first successful airplane that had controls that helped them to steer the plane. The flight by Orville lasted 12 seconds and went 120 feet. They were very brave because they did not know for sure that the plane would fly. God gives us the courage to try new adventures.

3. Will you make your First Communion this year at the age of seven? You can thank Pope Pius X whose feast is on **August 21**. For centuries, children did not receive Communion until age 13 or older after they had been confirmed. Pope Pius wanted children who had reached the “age of reason” to receive Jesus so he lowered the age. There are still many countries in South America where the children wait until they are over 10 years old or more before they receive Communion.

4. August 21 is National Senior Citizen Day. On this day we remember and celebrate the value and contribution of the elderly to our country. President Ronald Reagan said that for all they have done in their lifetimes, we should salute our older citizens. Why not take time this week to draw a picture or send a card to an elderly neighbor or relative and tell them how much you like them.
