The Baptism of the Lord

At first glance, the Baptism of the Lord might seem an odd feast. Since the Catholic Church teaches that the Sacrament of Baptism is necessary for the remission of sins, particularly Original Sin, why was Christ baptized? After all, He was born without Original Sin, and He lived His entire life without sinning. Therefore, He did not need the sacrament, as we do.


Christ's Baptism Foreshadows Our Own

In submitting Himself humbly to the baptism of St. John the Baptist, Christ provided the example for the rest of us. If even He should be baptized, though He did not need it, how much more should the rest of us be thankful for this sacrament, which frees us from the darkness of sin and incorporates us into the Church, the life of Christ on earth! His Baptism, therefore, was necessary—not for Him, but for us.

Descending into the waters of the Jordan, Jesus, who shares our humanity, makes that living water flow with healing mercy. His Divine Life is now mediated through the Sacraments in the life of the Church which is His Body. The Word descends and begins the re-creation of the universe. This is an ongoing work which will only be complete when He returns. We who are baptized into Him are called to participate in this ongoing redemptive mission. The public mission and ministry of Jesus began at the waters of Jordan. However, it continues through His Church, of which we are made members through Baptism.

The Christian vocation, no matter what our state in life, job, or specific response to God's call, is to reveal the Love of the Trinity to the entire human race, to bring them to the Waters of Baptism in order to encounter the Lord and experience New Life and be incorporated into the new humanity of the Church, which is the Body of Christ. There, joined in Him and with one another, we are called to participate in His ongoing redemptive mission until He returns to make all things new. We are invited on this Feast to grasp ever more deeply the heart of the Christian life and to choose to live our lives in the Lord, by living in the heart of the Church for the sake of the world.

Anointing of the Sick and Last Rites

During the pandemic, we have gotten some questions that suggest there is confusion about what we as a church are doing regarding the Sacrament of the Sick. **YES. WE ARE STILL CELEBRATING THIS SACRAMENT.** In life threatening/end of life situations, its always appropriate to contact the parish to request the sacrament. Before going in for a serious surgery is another appropriate time. If the person to be anointed is at home, Fr. Jon is willing to go to the home to celebrate the sacrament with you. If the person has tested positive for COVID and has not completed his/her isolation period, Father will wear personal protective equipment. This is also the case if anyone in the household is actively displaying symptoms, but has not received test results.

If the person is in a facility (e.g., hospital, nursing home), we will work in coordination with the staff of that facility. The challenge is that there widely different visitation policies from one institution to the next. As Catholics, we believe that human beings are both physical and spiritual. We believe that receiving the sacraments is immensely important for people's spiritual good circumstances of failing health, especially, end-of-life situations and that no Catholic should be deprived of this good. We also believe that public and personal health is a very real human good, that reason/science are not opposed to Faith. So we want to take appropriate precautions that balance the spiritual good of the sacraments and the physical good of personal and public health.

The important thing is to communicate with healthcare personnel and with your parish. In order to reach Fr. Jon in an emergency during business hours, please call the parish office, 849-9363, and indicate to the staff person answering the phone, that you would like to talk to Fr. Jon and that it is urgent. If it is after business hours, you may still call the parish office and the recorded greeting will prompt you to press one for emergencies. This will transfer your call to Father's cell phone so that your need can be addressed in a timely manner.

I hope this helps to clarify some confusion or uncertainty.


