

## God created man in his image; in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

By creating man and woman in His own image, God endowed the human race with the dignity that no other creature can claim and that can never be taken away. Therefore, human life must be cherished, valued, and protected above all else.

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States in its companion decisions Roe v Wade and Doe v Bolton. Since that time, millions of children have lost their lives, and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, designates January 22 a particular day of prayer and penance, called the <u>"Day of Prayer for the legal Protection of Unborn</u> <u>Children."</u> The Church directs:

In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or Jan. 23, when Jan. 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops sponsors an annual, nationwide novena called **9** Days for Life, which encompasses the liturgical observance of the Day of Prayer on January 22<sup>nd</sup>.

The **9** Days for Life is designed so that Catholics all across the nation can unite together in prayer for the protection of human life. Each day's intention is accompanied by a short reflection and suggested actions to help build a culture of life.

Good Shepherd will pray the novena each day after morning Mass between January 19 and January 27 and ask that you take a sheet home with you to continue the novena when we do not have morning Mass.


