

There are 5,981 Catholic schools nationwide. 4,812 of those are elementary/middle schools and 1,264 of those are rural schools. As an alumni (6th grade class of 1999), a parent of a current 2nd grader, and the new principal, I've seen CACS from all levels. As a student, I spent my most formative years under the guidance of the teachers here. I developed a relationship with Christ in a way that only Catholic schools can offer. I truly believe my successes in middle school, high school, and college can be attributed to the foundation of faith and academic excellence I received as a student here.

When I became a parent, I knew I wanted the same for my children. Two and a half years ago, my daughter began 5K at CACS and we once again became a part of the faith family of this school. Now as a parent, watching my daughter grow in many of the same ways I did through her Catholic school experience has been incredibly rewarding. When she would come home and talk about a new Bible story or saint she was learning about, or come home having learned a new prayer, up until this year where she has been preparing to receive the Sacraments, the love and joy of Jesus shines through her. Next year, my son will be starting 5K, and I'm so excited to see him grow in the same ways. CACS also offers a lot of opportunities for parents to get involved and grow their own relationship with Christ. This parental involvement is where I have met some of the most wonderful people who have helped me grow in Christ.

Now this year, I've embarked on my third experience with the CACS family - that of principal. This is my very first principal position, which would be incredibly overwhelming for anyone. But the people here have made this first year an incredible experience. I've felt welcomed and supported since day one. I can feel my faith once again growing stronger and I'm developing a new relationship with Christ, one that I felt was missing in my time away from CACS.

This is a truly special school. We are incredibly blessed to have CACS in our community as an option for our children. So when people ask what Catholic education means to me, I tell them it's home. It is where my relationship with Christ first flourished. It's where I can always come back to strengthen that relationship. It's where I will always feel supported and uplifted. I can't wait to help more and more children and their families find their home.


