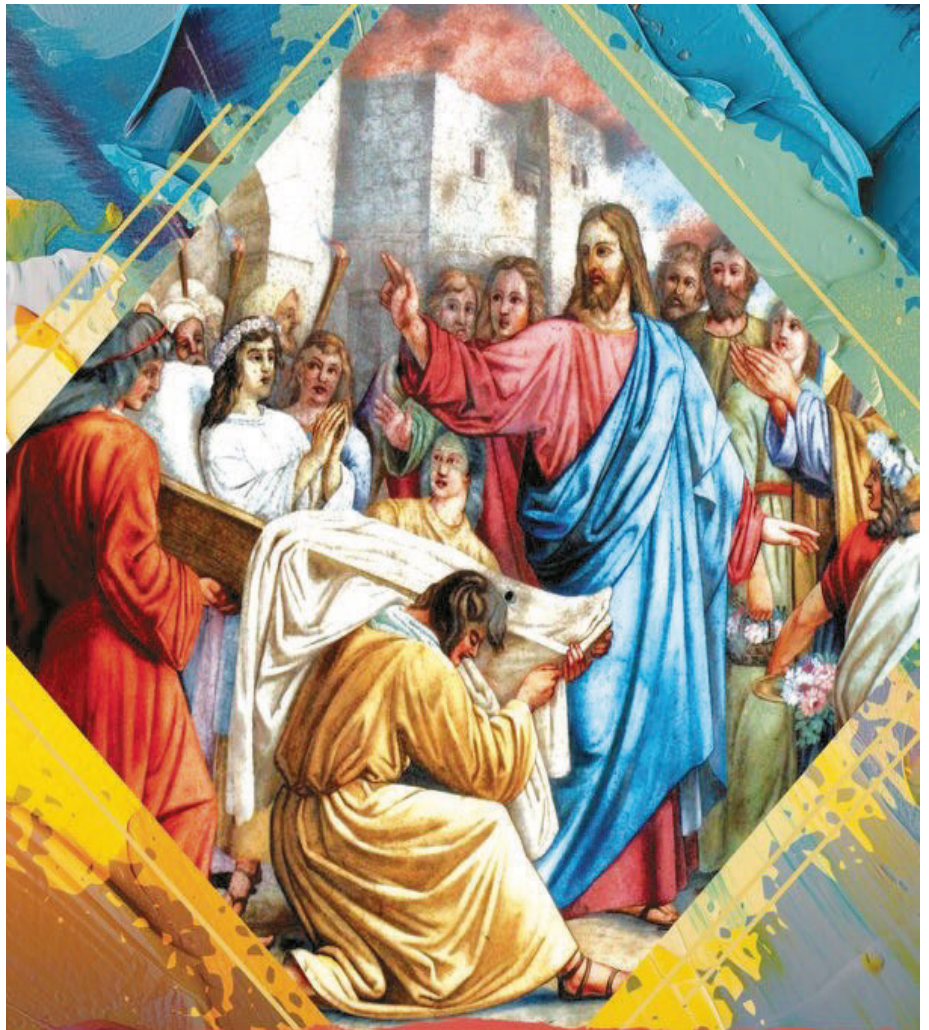

Annual Missionary Cooperation Plan – Visiting Missionary Appeal

Welcome Sr. Mary Miller and Sr. Maragaret Anne Norris from the Holy Spirit Missionary Sisters!

The Holy Spirit Missionary Sisters are an international, intercultural missionary congregation serving in over 50 countries of the world, primarily in rural, poor areas and frontier situations: addressing the needs of the people through education, health care, and socio-pastoral ministry. Special attention is given to women and children, trafficking, those affected by HIV/AIDS, inter-religious dialogue, and sharing the “Good News” of God’s love. The Holy Spirit Missionary Sisters is one of the 38 mission organizations who were invited to be a part of this year’s Missionary Cooperation Plan. Thank you, Sr. Mary and Sr. Margaret, for sharing your message with us!

The Missionary Cooperation Appeal (MCP) is promoted through the Catholic Foundation World Mission office every summer and is conducted in dioceses across the United States. These collections are a way to centralize the efforts of missionary organizations around the world who wish to appeal to Catholics in the U.S. Each year, from over 300 applications, Bishop Ricken invites 38 groups to participate. This Appeal allows mission groups to make a personal appeal for prayers and financial support from Catholics in our diocese. In our Diocese, receipts from all the 156 parishes are pooled and divided equally among these selected mission groups. We use this fair-share system to enable our missionary speakers to go to less populated parishes in our Diocese without fear of receiving less income. Missionaries share the needs and their faith experiences of the people they serve. Missionaries enrich us in our understanding of the problems and challenges of the global church. Our faith is deepened and broadened as we learn from them.

Updated Stipend & Stole Fee Structure

The Diocese of Green Bay and our parishes are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses, funerals, weddings, and Quinceaneras in the past.

The donation for these sacraments and services has remained the same for over thirty years throughout the Diocese of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time. The new stipend structure is as follows:

This new fee structure will become effective **July 1, 2024**. It will not be applied retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount from the former fee scale. The new fee structure will be applied to all new requests received as of July 1, 2024. As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament of service with no fee. Please know, too, that any stipend money collected goes to the parish in support of its ministry and services provided to the parish community; it does not go personally to the priest.
