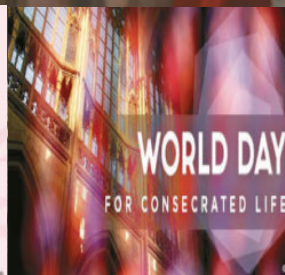

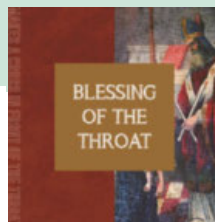

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Gospel of the Fourth Sunday in ordinary time invites us to reflect on Jesus' challenging words and actions as He begins His public ministry. In Luke 4:21-30, we hear the continuation of last week's Gospel, where Jesus reads from the scroll of Isaiah in the synagogue. He declares that He is the fulfillment of that Scripture, proclaiming good news to the poor, freedom for captives, and healing for the broken-hearted.

However, the reaction of His hometown in Nazareth is striking. What begins with admiration quickly turns to anger as Jesus challenges their expectations and reminds them of God's boundless mercy, extending even to outsiders. Their rejection of Him serves as an emotional reminder of how human pride and narrow-mindedness can block the transformative work of God's love.

The other readings for this Sunday emphasize the power of God's love and our call to live it out. In 1 Corinthians 12:31–13:13, St. Paul describes love as the greatest virtue, one that is patient, kind, and never fails. This aligns beautifully with the call to reflect God's love not only toward those who are easy to love but also toward those who challenge us.

As we meditate on this Sunday's readings, let's ask ourselves:

- How do we respond when Jesus challenges us to go beyond our comfort zones?
- Are we open to embracing God's plan, even when it surprises or stretches us?

May this Sunday encourage us to grow in humility, faith, and love as we walk in the footsteps of Christ.

I request all of you to please, keep me in your valuable prayers.

St. Blaise Blessing of the Throat, Mini Explanation

Perhaps it's an example of divine providence that the feast of St. Blaise falls on Feb. 3 — right in the middle of cold and flu season! This fourth-century Armenian saint was a bishop and martyr and is venerated as the patron of those who suffer from illnesses of the throat.

On his feast day, Catholics traditionally receive a blessing of the throat. This blessing is administered by a priest, deacon or a lay minister who follows the rites and prayers designated for a layperson. During the blessing, the minister takes two candles that were blessed on the feast of the Presentation and makes a cross in front of the throat, saying "Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness." A priest or deacon will then make the sign of the cross. Please respond "Amen"
