





Dear Parish Members:

The Festival Committee met again on December 15th to discuss a possible festival for 2022 and would like your input. We will be meeting again on January 12th, so your comments and ideas before then would be greatly appreciated. Please return this letter to the Parish Office, leave it with an usher at Mass, or email your comments to (Cecilia or Vanessa?). (Not sure what you want to do here).

The Committee decided that a one-day festival was too much work, with no guarantee of it being a success, since there is always a chance of bad weather. We originally thought this could work because we may be able to get enough volunteers for a shorter event. We then discussed various options of moving many things inside and scaling down what is usually outside. If we do have a festival, it would be a minimum of two days. It has been increasingly difficult from year to year to get enough volunteers to keep all of the booths open for four days, and we're wondering if we could get enough help if we had the festival for two days instead. Please indicate below if you would be willing to volunteer at a festival for one or two days, or both. Please include your name so we know who we can count on.

We also discussed having a sweepstakes again in 2022, just like we did in 2021. We received a great response to the sweepstakes and are wondering if you would be willing to make a similar donation if we had a sweepstakes in 2022.

Another option that was suggested was instead of having a festival, we would have fish fries, dances, craft fairs, trivia nights, etc. throughout the year. The Festival Committee can't organize and work at all of these types of fundraisers, so we would again need volunteers. Would you be interested in organizing and/or working at these types of events?

Thank you so much for your feedback. It will help us make a decision that will meet the needs of our parish going forward.

Estimados miembros de la parroquia

El Comité del Festival se reunió nuevamente el 15 de diciembre para discutir un posible festival para 2022 y quisiera su opinión. Nos reuniremos nuevamente el 12 de enero, por lo que sus comentarios e ideas antes de esa fecha serán muy apreciados. Por favor devuelva esta carta a la oficina parroquial, déjela con un acomodador en la misa o envíe sus comentarios por correo electrónico a (Cecilia o Vanessa?). El Comité decidió que un festival de un día era demasiado trabajo, sin garantía de que fuera un éxito, ya que siempre existe la posibilidad de mal tiempo. Originalmente pensamos que esto podría funcionar porque podríamos conseguir suficientes voluntarios para un evento más corto. Luego discutimos varias opciones para mover muchas cosas hacia adentro y reducir lo que generalmente está afuera. Si tenemos un festival, sería un mínimo de dos días. Ha sido cada vez más difícil de un año a otro conseguir suficientes voluntarios para mantener todos los puestos abiertos durante cuatro días, y nos preguntamos si podríamos obtener suficiente ayuda si tuviéramos el festival durante dos días. Indique a continuación si estaría dispuesto a ser voluntario en un festival durante uno o dos días, o ambos. Incluya su nombre para que sepamos con quién podemos contar.

También hablamos de tener un sorteo nuevamente en 2022, al igual que lo hicimos en 2021. Recibimos una gran respuesta al sorteo y nos preguntamos si estaría dispuesto a hacer una donación similar si tuviéramos un sorteo en 2022.

Otra opción que se sugirió fue que en lugar de tener un festival, tendríamos pescado frito, bailes, ferias de artesanías, noches de trivia, etc. durante todo el año. El Comité del Festival no puede organizar y trabajar en todos estos tipos de eventos para recaudar fondos, por lo que nuevamente necesitaríamos voluntarios. ¿Estaría interesado en organizar y / o trabajar en este tipo de eventos?
