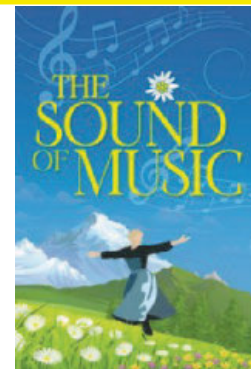
K5A had the opportunity to have a Polar Express Day prior to Christmas break. The class got to come in their pajamas, bring a

- The bus has three regular pick up locations.
- The first is the northeast corner of St. Roman Parish Parking Lot. Please enter the parking lot using the driveway on Bolivar Avenue and park toward the back of the lot where the bus will load. If the bus is at a different spot, please stay in the designated loading area until it is directed to that area. Do not enter the bus until invited to by the host/hostess for the trip. The bus is scheduled to arrive at 7:45 am and leave for the next pick up location at 8:00 am.
- The second location is the main door at Wilson Commons. People requesting pick up at Wilson Commons should be at the door by 8:05 am. We will depart as soon as everyone is on the bus.
- The final regular pick up location is Highland Grove Apartments at approximately 8:25 am. Please be ready ahead of time in case the bus arrives early.
- There is a stop at Jones Farms scheduled prior to the show.
- Arrival back at St. Roman Parish is expected to be between 6:00 and 6:30 pm, depending on the length of the show and traffic.
- The reservation deadline for this March 3, 2022 trip, along with the full payment of \$100 per person, is Friday, January 28, 2022. This payment does **NOT** include the bus driver tip, so please be prepared to contribute for that on the day of the show.
- Please return the form below to St. Roman Parish, Attention: Karen Gasperetti, 1710 W Bolivar Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53221 along with full payment of \$100.00 per person, as soon as possible, to insure your spots. Remember to choose your Entrée. Spots are reserved **ONLY** upon receipt of the reservation with full payment. Once the check is issued to the Fireside, no refunds will be made. A credit for a future show would be kept in your name.

- No handicap seating will be provided since everyone in attendance needs to be able to walk more than the length of the bus throughout the trip.
