School News.

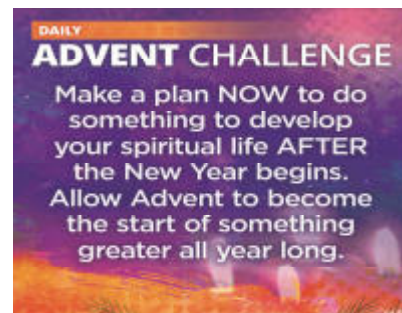
