Anyone who would like to take an old hymnal may do so. There are several hymnals in church in the north side devotional area. Please feel free to take as many as you would like.

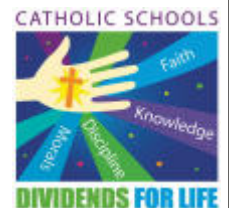
School News.
