

## **AmeriGas School Days Program**

AmeriGas tallies up the total gallons tied to each customer registered for a specified school and pays 2 cents per gallon, up to \$2,000 per year, at the end of the School Days Program. For example, if we have 100 AmeriGas customers using 500 gallons each during the year, check would be \$1,000 for the school. The more customers enrolled, the more that is earned. In September AmeriGas will total the propane gallons delivered for all the customers enrolled for St. Rose and send the check in the fall of 2022. AmeriGas customers must fill out a participant form for the school days program found online at www.amerigas.com or by calling 844-711-3046 and using the school ID number and their account number. The school ID for St. Rose is **729105372.** Customers need to only register once to be counted for the full program year. Customers must be registered by 8/31/22 to be counted for the 2021-22 program cycle. We recently received a check for \$486 for the school from the 2020/21 program year. Thanks to all who participated in this program.
