


“Giving Tree” Thank You Note

As years went by, the attendance in the chapel swelled to capacity. It was decided to relocate to a larger space in the north-west corner of the lower level. On May 22nd, 2005, after much hard work and needed prayers, the Christ the King Chapel was rededicated in its present location.

Our pastors over the years, Msgr. Klister, Fr. Farrell, and Fr. Cirignani, and now Fr. José, have viewed the chapel as an important aspect to the faith life of our community especially when so many churches in the area are locked. People need a place to pray during their time of need. Simply put "we become who we gaze upon".

The prayers from the chapel, it seems, have increased interest in vocations as several young men from our parish became seminarians and priests.

José, ha visto la capilla como un aspecto importante para la vida de fe de nuestra comunidad, especialmente cuando tantas iglesias en el área están cerradas. La gente necesita un lugar para orar durante su tiempo de necesidad. En pocas palabras, "nos convertimos en quienes miramos".

Las oraciones de la capilla, al parecer, han aumentado el interés en las vocaciones a medida que varios jóvenes de nuestra parroquia se convirtieron en seminaristas y sacerdotes.

Dear Parish Family,

*“You are my beloved Son,
in which I am pleased”
(Lk 3:22).*

God the Father so powerfully letting His voice be heard for the sake of us all, to announce Jesus Christ, the beloved Son whose birth we just celebrated, and whose mission continues until the end of the world.

His mission is to rescue souls from the kingdom of darkness to lead them to the Father in the kingdom of light! The Book of the Acts of the Apostles reminds us that Jesus Christ was anointed with the Holy Spirit and with power... *“He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil...”* (Acts 10:38).

God the Father bestows His love and His power upon Jesus so that He can help us in the battle with Satan. Jesus' mission is to restore humanity back to the original holiness that we had in the garden of Eden. It is Jesus' goal to heal and bring the Father's mercy to every soul that has been beaten and broken by Satan's hatred.

What a privilege it is to have been the recipient of the Father's mercy at the moment of our own baptism, and every time we approach any of the other sacraments. That power that Jesus received from His Father is the same power that He then bestows upon those who approach Him with confidence.

Just as heaven was torn open for the Holy Spirit to descend upon Jesus, so it is that same reality for any of us who approach the Lord in the sacraments of His Church. Power and grace is bestowed upon us – God's beloved children – so that we may be able to live our true identities, as beloved sons and daughters of the Father. This grace and power that God bestows upon us is what restores us to that original holiness that we had with the Father in heaven before the fall.

As we ponder Jesus' own baptism, may we ask the Father to bestow upon us – in a powerful and real way – the fire of the Holy Spirit.

It is God's own love that restores and purifies our souls. It is that love that impels us to persevere in our relationship with God and our pursuit of holiness. For indeed you and I are God's beloved sons and daughters, so much so that Jesus Christ has come to defend us from Satan himself.

You and I are worthy of the great sacrifice that the beloved Son has made for us on the Cross, simply because the Father loves us so deeply.

Come Holy Spirit, enkindle in us the fire of your love!

“Tú eres mi Hijo amado; en ti me complazco” (Lc 3, 22).

¡Dios Padre dejando que su voz se escuche tan poderosamente para el bien de todos nosotros! Jesucristo, el Hijo amado cuyo nacimiento acabamos de celebrar y cuya misión continúa hasta el fin del mundo.

¡La misión es de rescatar almas del reino de las tinieblas para llevarlas al Padre en el reino de la luz! El libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles nos recuerda que Jesucristo fue ungido con el Espíritu Santo y con poder... *“Y pasó haciendo bienes y sanando a todos los oprimidos por el diablo...”* (Hechos 10:38).
