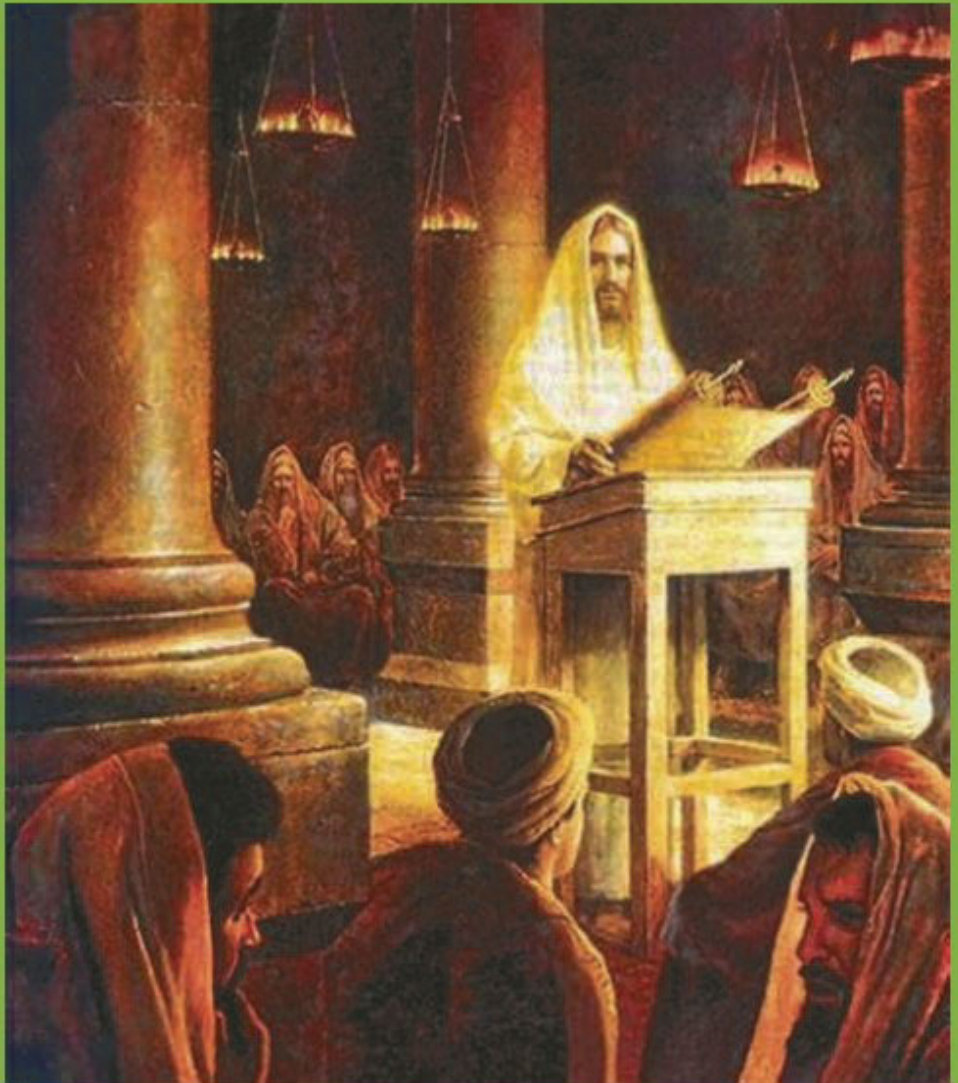

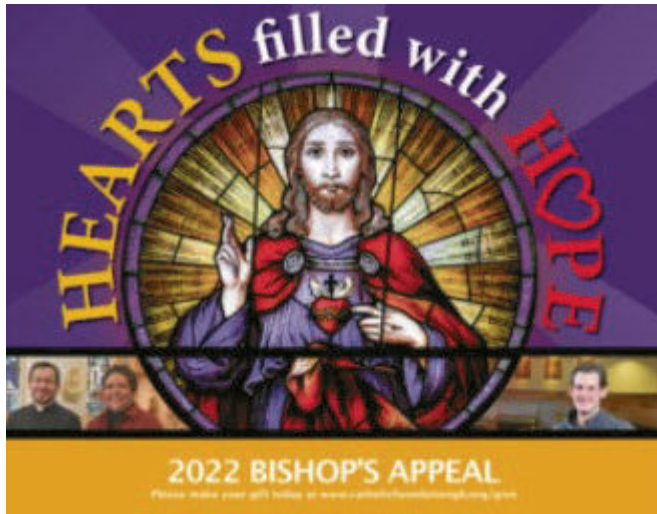

Dear Parish Family,

As Thank you so much for all of your prayers, love, and support while I was on retreat! It was truly an anointed time with our Lord in prayer. Please know that you and your family were in my prayers throughout this retreat.

In today's gospel, Jesus comes in power with the Holy Spirit to fulfill what the Father had promised in the Old Testament. With that great power of the Holy Spirit, our Lord wants to bring *“glad tidings to the poor, proclaim liberty to the captives, sight to the blind and to let the oppressed go free”* (Lk 4:14-21).

There is a lot of joy and grace in these few words. For example, in bringing glad tidings to the poor, we are not simply talking about giving a few coins to someone in need on the street. While that it is a good and beautiful thing to do for those in need, what the Gospel is talking about is something much more than that!

The glad tidings that Jesus is bringing is like taking someone out of the street, and bringing him into a mansion where he will never ever be lacking anything. The rest of his life he will have plenty for himself and those he loves.

Think about the difference between giving a homeless man a couple of coins vs. taking him into a mansion and providing for him for the rest of his life! The difference in the generosity provided is massive, but more importantly, how much joy and gladness it would be for those on the receiving end.

Very often, we don't realize that we are that homeless person that God himself, in His Son Jesus Christ, has come to rescue and take into the mansion of the Father! Not only does He bring us into His mansion, the Church, and God-willing heaven, but He himself feeds us daily with supernatural bread that has the power to totally change our lives!

If we would only ponder more often the great generosity of the Father for our sake! Jesus indeed wants to bring the glad tidings of the fact that He assumed our humanity for the sake of restoring us

back to that original holiness that He had created us with. This joy of the Father is much more than just a mere feeling, but the great news of His power that can change our lives!

This power of His love is giving to us at every Mass. Jesus Christ Himself comes to let us know that we are not abandoned and He desires to take us home back to the Father. May we ponder the glad tidings that we receive, because the Son of God comes from heaven at every Mass just for our sake, out of pure and sincere love for us! That is good news! Love itself is freely poured out to us!

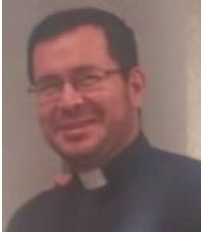

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

¡Muchas gracias por todas sus oraciones, amor y apoyo mientras estaba en el retiro! Fue verdaderamente un tiempo ungido con nuestro Señor en oración. Sepan que usted y su familia estuvieron en mis oraciones durante este retiro.

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús viene con el poder del Espíritu Santo para cumplir lo que el Padre había prometido en el Antiguo Testamento como escuchamos en la primera lectura. Con ese gran poder del Espíritu Santo, nuestro Señor quiere llevar *“la buena nueva a los pobres, proclamar libertad a los cautivos, vista a los ciegos y dejar en libertad a los oprimidos”* (Lc 4, 14-21).

Hay mucha alegría y gracia en estas pocas palabras. Por ejemplo, al llevar buenas nuevas a los pobres, no estamos hablando simplemente de dar unas monedas a alguien en la calle que lo necesite. Si bien es bueno y hermoso hacer algo por los necesitados, ¡de lo que habla el Evangelio es algo mucho más que eso!

La buena nueva que trae Jesús es como sacar a alguien de la calle, a un vagabundo, y llevarlo a una mansión donde nunca jamás le faltará nada más. El resto de su vida tendrá mucho para sí mismo y para aquellos a quienes ama. Piense en la diferencia entre darle un par de monedas a un vagabundo y llevarlo a una mansión y mantenerlo por el resto de su vida. Gran diferencia en la generosidad proporcionada, pero especialmente en la alegría que sería para aquellos que la reciben.

¡Muchas veces no nos damos cuenta de que nosotros somos esa persona vagabunda que Dios mismo en Su Hijo, Jesucristo, ha venido a rescatarnos y llevarnos a la mansión del Padre! ¡No solo nos lleva a Su mansión, la Iglesia y el cielo si Dios quiere, sino que Él mismo nos alimenta diariamente con pan sobrenatural (su cuerpo) que tiene el poder de cambiar totalmente nuestras vidas!

¡Ojalá que reflexionemos más a menudo sobre la gran generosidad del Padre con nosotros! Jesús de hecho quiere traer la buena nueva, el hecho de que Él asumió nuestra humanidad con el fin de restaurarnos de nuevo a esa santidad original con la que Él nos había coronado. Este gozo del Padre es mucho más que un simple sentimiento, ¡sino la gran noticia de Su poder que puede cambiar nuestras vidas!

Este poder de Su amor nos lo está dando en cada Misa. Jesucristo mismo viene a hacernos saber que no estamos abandonados y que desea llevarnos de regreso al Padre.

¡Meditemos en la buena nueva que recibimos porque el Hijo de Dios, viene del cielo en cada Misa sólo por nosotros, por amor puro y sincero hacia nosotros! ¡Esas son buenas noticias! ¡El Amor mismo es libremente derramado sobre nosotros!
