### Amen Generosity

In today's culture we have learned to see time in very small pieces. Drive-through convenience, technological advances, and new ideas of customer service have all taught us to expect things quickly. On-line ordering and delivery have changed how we expect our lives to flow. Rarely do we have to wait more than a day for anything. In centuries past, time was seen in much bigger blocks. Most people never saw a clock much less one with a quartz-accurate second hand. Time was perceived in days, weeks and seasons. If you were aware of the time of day it was mostly through the position of the sun in the sky, or perhaps the tolling of distant bells.

This larger concept of time affected how people saw their world and their role within it. Many projects, especially something like a great Gothic Cathedral, were only accomplished through several lifetimes. Those who started the project never saw its completion. Those who prayed within a Cathedral's walls rarely had been there when the cornerstone was laid. Yet everyone pitched in to make these monuments to God a reality. We complain the Road construction takes months to complete. Imagine living lifetimes, while the center of town, where a cathedral was being built, was filled with constant construction traffic. The Cathedral reminded each generation that they were part of a larger whole. That Church of whom they were a part spanned not only many places but also many times. Often people would labor on a Cathedral with only the vaguest notion of what it would look like. They only knew that they were a part of something bigger than themselves.

We need to recapture this sense of time and this sense of belonging to something bigger than ourselves. Our parish has a rich history dating back over 120 years. As a community of faith we have watched this neighborhood grow around us and seen generations of families build homes, raise children and move on. We have weathered wars and depressions. We have shared each other's tragedies and celebrated each other's joys. We are part of something bigger than ourselves. And when we share the Eucharist, Jesus is in our midst. That makes us part of something even grander – the kingdom of God. This week I invite you to reflect on our parish as a little corner of the Kingdom of God. And give thanks.

### Amén Generosidad

En la cultura de hoy hemos aprendido a ver el tiempo en partes muy pequeñas. La conveniencia de conducir, los avances tecnológicos y las nuevas ideas de servicio al cliente nos han enseñado a esperar cosas rápidamente. Los pedidos y la entrega en línea han cambiado la forma en que esperamos que fluya nuestra vida. Rara vez tenemos que esperar más de un día para algo. En siglos pasados, el tiempo se veía en bloques mucho más grandes. La mayoría de las personas nunca vieron un reloj, mucho menos uno con un segundero con precisión de cuarzo. El tiempo se percibió en días, semanas y estaciones. Si estaba al tanto de la hora del día, era principalmente a través de la posición del sol en el cielo, o tal vez el sonido de las campanas distantes.

Este concepto más amplio de tiempo afectó cómo las personas veían su mundo y su papel dentro de él. Muchos proyectos, especialmente obras grandes como una gran catedral gótica, solo se realizaban a lo largo de varias vidas. Los que comenzaron el proyecto nunca vieron su finalización. Los que rezaban dentro de los muros de una catedral rara vez habían estado allí cuando se colocó la piedra angular. Sin embargo, todos colaboraron para hacer realidad estos monumentos a Dios. Nos quejamos de que la construcción de la carretera lleva meses en completarse. Imagine vivir toda la vida mientras el centro de la ciudad, donde se estaba construyendo una catedral, estaba lleno de ajetreo constante de la construcción. La catedral le recordaba a cada generación, que formaban parte de un todo más grande. Esa Iglesia de la que formaban parte abarcaba no solo muchos lugares sino también mucho tiempo. A menudo, las personas trabajaban en una catedral con una vaga noción de cómo se vería una vez finalizada. Solo sabían que eran parte de algo más grande que ellos.

Necesitamos recuperar este sentido del tiempo y este sentido de pertenencia a algo más grande que nosotros. Nuestra parroquia tiene una rica historia que se remonta a más de 120 años. Como comunidad de fe, hemos visto crecer este vecindario a nuestro alrededor y hemos visto a generaciones de familias construir casas, criar hijos y seguir adelante. Hemos resistido guerras y depresiones. Hemos compartido las tragedias y celebrado alegrías. Somos parte de algo más grande que nosotros mismos. Y cuando compartimos la Eucaristía, Jesús está en medio de nosotros. Eso nos hace parte de algo aún más grandioso: el reino de Dios. Esta semana los invito a reflexionar sobre nuestra parroquia como un pequeño rincón del Reino de Dios. Y dar gracias.
