Holy Homework!

The church gives us lifetime homework assignments such as prayer and acts of kindness. Virtues are things we must strive to do continually throughout our whole lives. As your Music Director or "Music Minister" I feel it is my duty to encourage all of you to take on another ongoing assignment which is to practice singing.

Most of you have probably had the experience of sounding better singing in the shower than you normally would. This is probably due to the aid of acoustic reverberation on the bathroom walls and of being in a situation of reduced social pressure. All of this might seem like a novelty with no real use for the majority of parishioners who have no plans for a career in singing, but there is one very important reason why we should all take our vocal practice a little more seriously, ... to praise the Lord! Each of us can better contribute to the celebration of Mass by improving our singing voice. A Mass with vibrant singing can help us all to feel more like a Church community and can bring us to a deeper sense that we are all part of the mystical body of Christ. So, the next time you find yourself singing for fun remember that you are also practicing for the Lord and his Church.

Also remember to sing loudly sometimes. The vocal cords are muscles that must be exercised. Although we must take care not to hurt ourselves by always singing without vocal pain and by never trying to sing lower than our vocal range allows, we must sometimes sing loudly to add extra "weight" to our exercise routine. Imagine going to the gym and doing bench presses with just the bar and no weights. Without added weight we can expect minimal results. Using the same logic, we must sometimes sing loudly to increase the strength of our vocal muscles.

We might not all be called to be a St. Clare of Assisi or a St. Francis of Assisi but if we all took our call to be saints seriously, imagine how our Church could be transformed. In the same way we are called to sing to the Lord at whatever level we are able and contribute to this beautiful expression of communal praise and thanksgiving. So please do your homework; you might just be glad you did!

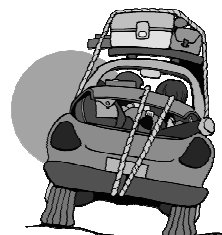
La mayoría de ustedes probablemente han tenido la experiencia de sonar mejor cantando en la ducha de lo que sonaría normalmente. Probablemente esto se debe a la ayuda de la reverberación acústica en las paredes del baño y a estar en una situación de presión social reducida. Todo esto puede parecer una novedad sin utilidad real para la mayoría de los feligreses que no tienen planes de tener una carrera en canto, pero hay una razón muy importante por la que todos deberíamos tomar nuestra práctica vocal un poco más en serio, ... para alabar al Señor! Cada uno de nosotros puede contribuir mejor a la celebración de la Misa mejorando nuestra voz al cantar. Una Misa con un canto vibrante puede ayudarnos a todos a sentirnos más como una comunidad parroquial y puede llevarnos a un sentido más profundo de que todos somos parte del cuerpo místico de Cristo. Entonces, la próxima vez que se encuentren cantando por diversión, recuerden que también están practicando para el Señor y su Iglesia.

También recuerden que es importante cantar fuerte en algunos momentos. Las cuerdas vocales son músculos que deben ejercitarse. Aunque debemos tener cuidado de no lastimarnos, cantando siempre sin dolor vocal y nunca tratando de cantar más abajo de lo que permite nuestro registro vocal, a veces debemos cantar fuerte para agregar "peso" extra a nuestra rutina de ejercicios. Imagínese ir al gimnasio y levantar pesas con solo la barra. Sin peso adicional, podemos esperar resultados mínimos. Usando la misma lógica, a veces debemos cantar fuerte para aumentar la fuerza de nuestros músculos vocales.

Puede que no todos seamos llamados a ser Santa Clara de Asís o San Francisco de Asís, pero si todos tomáramos en serio nuestro llamado a ser santos, imaginen cómo podríamos ayudar a transformar la Iglesia. De la misma manera estamos llamados a cantar al Señor en el nivel que estemos para contribuir a esta hermosa expresión de alabanza y acción de gracias comunitaria. Así que por favor haga su tarea; ¡quizás te alegrarás de haberlo hecho!
