Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we conclude the Christmas season with the celebration of the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. All three of the Synoptic Gospels ("synoptic" meaning "with one eye", the gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke) record this incredible event in which Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist in the Jordan River. After coming up out of the water, the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus and the Father proclaimed Him to be His Beloved Son. In the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, we become beloved daughters and sons of God the Father by adoption (His choosing) and the Holy Spirit comes to us in all fullness to strengthen us for mission. Rooted in our relationship with God as His beloved children, we are all called to a share in His mission to bring all people to salvation in Christ. That means we are all called, in our own way, to evangelize.

This year, the Archbishop has asked us to focus on evangelization. So many people in our families, in our community, our country and our world are in desperate need of coming to know Jesus, and it is our role as disciples to do our best to help facilitate that encounter. The first step in evangelization is rooted in today's feast. It is simply to root our lives in a relationship with God our Father; to know ourselves to be His beloved daughter or son. Have you ever stopped to prayerfully consider that you are His beloved? That the Father delights in you and holds you in the palm of His hand? That despite your failures and sins, He is Mercy and still looks on you in love, welcoming you back with open arms? As we begin to focus this year on evangelization, let us all take some time to focus on this first step, to know ourselves in the light of His Face as His beloved daughters and sons.

Every January, the seminarians at Kenrick-Glennon seminary make their annual retreat. Once again, I have been asked to be a spiritual director on this retreat, which begins this Sunday evening. So, a request and some scheduling details...First, the request is simply to pray for our seminarians and spiritual directors. As to the schedule, I will be gone from Sunday evening January 9th to Thursday evening January 13th. Monday through Thursday we will have communion services at 8am, and adoration will continue as usual. Wednesday confessions will be cancelled on January 12th. Have a blessed week!





Saint of the Week

Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phyrgia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.


