## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK .....

#### Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we begin Passiontide, which traditionally is the last two weeks of Lent. During this time, our focus is more on the suffering, passion and death of Our Lord. It is a time for us to prayerfully reflect on the incredible love of our God Who died on the Cross for our sins, and so to repent sincerely and try to refashion ourselves after the Gospel.

During this holy time, we will have a few extra opportunities to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This Wednesday we will have our regularly scheduled confessions from 5pm to 6pm. On Saturday April 9th, we will have an extra hour of confessions, beginning at 3pm and going until shortly before mass at 5pm. Then on Monday April 11th, we will have confessions from 7pm until 8:30pm. Finally we will once again have our regularly scheduled confessions on Wednesday April 13th from 5pm to 6pm. There will be no confession times during the Sacred Triduum, that it from Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday. (Remember on Holy Saturday, because of the Easter Vigil, there is no 4pm confession or 5pm mass.)

On another note, I want to thank all of you who have participated in the Disciple Maker Index survey for the All Things New initiative. We had a great turnout, and if you haven't filled out the survey there is still time, as the online survey will be live through Monday, April 4th. On April 5th, there will be another survey available for anyone who has been involved in our Catholic schools in any way. This survey is meant to help us understand how to make our schools better tools of evangelization and service to our communities. Information as to how to access this survey will be made available at mass and on the parish website.

Speaking of these surveys, each pastor has been asked to appoint a small group of five parishioners to assist him in this process. These people are Bob Dobsch, Jay Nowak, Joe Boland, Lori Brinkmann and Mandy Eckelkamp. In addition, one person was to be chosen to be the key point of contact and communication between the parish and the Archdiocese, and here at OLL, that person is our DRE, Katelyn Boland. Special thanks to these parishioners for their time and help. To be clear, they are not decision makers in this process, and neither am I. They are here to help analyze the data, contextualize it, communicate with the Archdiocese and disseminate information to the parish. I would ask for your prayerful support of these parishioners and myself and for the leadership of All Things New for the gift of wisdom.



**6th Graders** are completing extension activities for the Middle Ages.


