FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK....

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Memorial Day weekend! In addition to the start of summer, this is a weekend of remembering. Of course this weekend we are officially remembering the men and women who

have given their lives fighting for our country. This weekend may be a busy one for many of us, but let's not forget to prayerfully remember those who gave the ultimate sacrifice for our freedoms. As Catholics, we have a great tradition, rooted in Scripture, of praying for the dead. So, as we celebrate Memorial Day, we pray for the repose of the souls of those who died for our country. One great way to do that is to join us for mass on Memorial Day at 9 am.

On another note, I'd like to mention that, as Catholics, remembering is important to us in other ways. First of all, memory is central to our celebration of the Eucharist. The Mass is called a memorial sacrifice, because it is a making present of the one Sacrifice on Calvary. The Hebrew people believed that when they celebrated Passover, that memorial wasn't just a looking back, but a making present of the Lord and the gift of the Passover of the Lord. Every celebration of the Mass is not so much a looking back, but a making present of Jesus' Sacrifice for our salvation. Another way we as Catholics revere memory is in our spiritual lives. In each of our lives, the Lord is at work, sometimes making Himself known to us in various ways. One of the most helpful spiritual practices we can make use of is 'repetition' or going back in our prayer to those times that God has previously manifested Himself to us. This use of memory helps us through difficult times, reminding us of the works of the Lord and thus strengthening us to continue our spiritual journey. Anyway, just a few spiritual thoughts to chew on as we celebrate Memorial Day.




School Summer Hours




