FROM THE DESK OF FR. NICK ...

As we pray for the election of a new Pope, it is worthwhile to reflect on the question: What's the deal with Popes? The title "Pope" simply means "father." In the first two centuries of Christianity, it was merely an affectionate term for a father. Just as we call priests "father" today, the term "Pope" was used for bishops and priests. After a century or two, it fell out of ordinary use as people began using a different word for "dad" and became more of a specific title. By the time you get to the year 500, it's only used for the Pope in Rome and for the bishop of Alexandria in Egypt.

The first official title of the Pope is "bishop of Rome." Just as St. Louis has a Bishop, so does the city of Rome. At the time of Jesus, Rome was the capital of the world. It was to Rome that God called Saints Peter and Paul, the princes of the apostles, to share the word of God. Jesus appeared in the heart of the Jewish world, but the explosive message of God's mercy was not meant to remain within the Jewish world; rather, it was meant to reach the entire world from its capital in Rome.

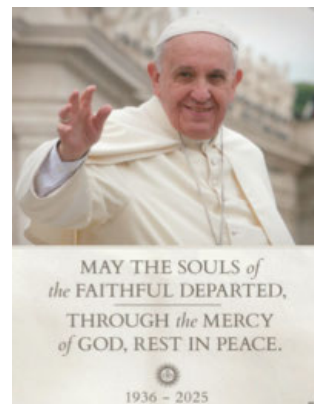
St. Paul boldly appeals his case to the emperor in Acts 25:12. He uses his right as a citizen of Rome to be judged by Caesar. He doesn't believe he will receive fair treatment. Appeals to the emperor would be slow and often resulted in harsher punishment for wasting the great man's time. Paul wanted to bring the Gospel to the most powerful man in the world and was more than willing to pay the price with his life.

Peter goes to Rome as well. "In the same reign of Claudius, the all-good and kindly Providence of the universe guided Peter, the great and mighty one of the Apostles, because of his virtue the spokesman for all the others, to Rome, as if against a great corrupter of life." (Eusebius of Caesarea, trans. Roy Joseph Deferrari.) There in Rome, the city that conquered the world, the leaders among the Apostles would preach and die, planting the seeds that would have the Gospel conquer the world.

The word "bishop" means overseer. You need someone to oversee things. In the New Testament, three different roles emerge for leaders in the church: overseer (that is, bishop), elder (that is, priest), and servant (that is, deacon). The Apostles were overseers, elders, and servants, but those named deacons only had the role of service and not the role of overseeing or leading. As the Apostles died, their successors took only the title of overseer in deference to the fact that the Apostles were called directly by Jesus. Thus, those who succeeded the Apostles in preaching and overseeing the flock were called overseers, or in English: bishops.

The Pope is a bishop, and he is a bishop just like any other bishop. Not being the Pope doesn't make any other bishop less of a bishop. But as Bishop of Rome, he has a responsibility to lead and strengthen the whole church.

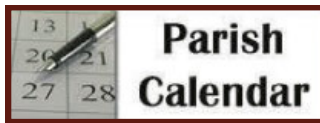

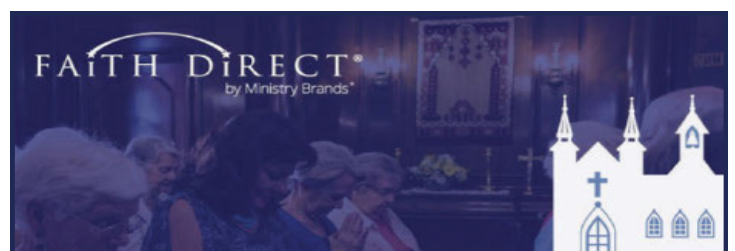
