Dear Fellow parishioners,

This past week on Wednesday, June 26, 2019 we began a new chapter in the life of Divine Mercy Parish. As you all know, we are now without a resident pastor. Although this announcement may seem a bit dismal, hopefully by next year at this time we will be blessed to have a pastor. I truly believe it will be a time for all of us to step up a notch to get involved in the life of our wonderful Parish. There are so many ministries within the parish, so if you are wondering what you should do, please take a little time to pray and reflect to see where God is calling you to serve. It also is a time for us to pray like never before for vocations to the priesthood.

When I met with Bishop Siegel, he emphasized that the most important part of my job is to "keep the momentum going". He commented that we are a very strong and vibrant parish and we want it to remain that way. The bishop also reminded me that's why we didn't get a pastor--because he knew that we would continue to stand firm in our faith.

Father Tim Tenbarge has graciously agreed to be our "primary" priest during this interim. In other words, Father Tim will be here almost every weekend. With that in mind:

1. We will continue to have Mass on the weekends at the same time and location as before.
2. Mass will still be offered on Tuesday evening at 6:00pm at St. Anthony and Wednesday evening at 6:00pm at Sacred Heart.
3. There will be no Thursday or Friday morning Mass in our Parish.
4. Confessions will be held at 4:00pm before the Saturday evening Mass and also on the First Sunday of the month at 7:00am at Sacred Heart and 9:30am at St. Anthony. Also, if you would like to go by appointment, simply call me at the Parish Office and I will ask Father Tim to be in the confessional (You can certainly remain anonymous)
5. Father Tim will make himself available for funerals. If a funeral is on a Tuesday or Wednesday morning at either church, there will **not** be Mass in the evening
6. Deacon Charlie has agreed to do all the marriage prep along with our sponsor couples. If you are planning your wedding, please call me at the Parish Office and I will contact Deacon Charlie.
7. If you or a family member needs to be anointed, please call me at the Parish office. If I am unavailable at the time, leave a message as I will continue to check my messages every day.

Now for a sigh of relief, I will not be writing a letter on a weekly basis---only when I feel the need arises. So let's all get ready to see what God has in store for us.

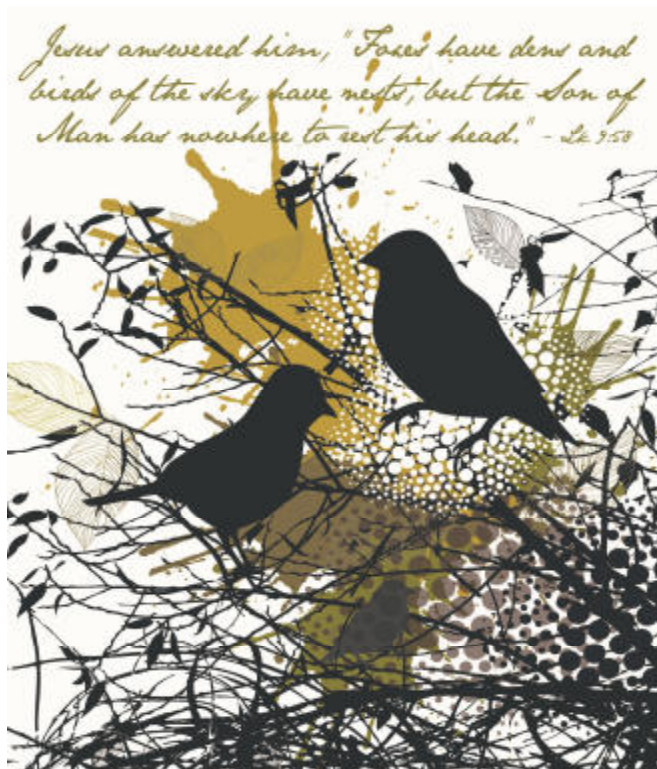

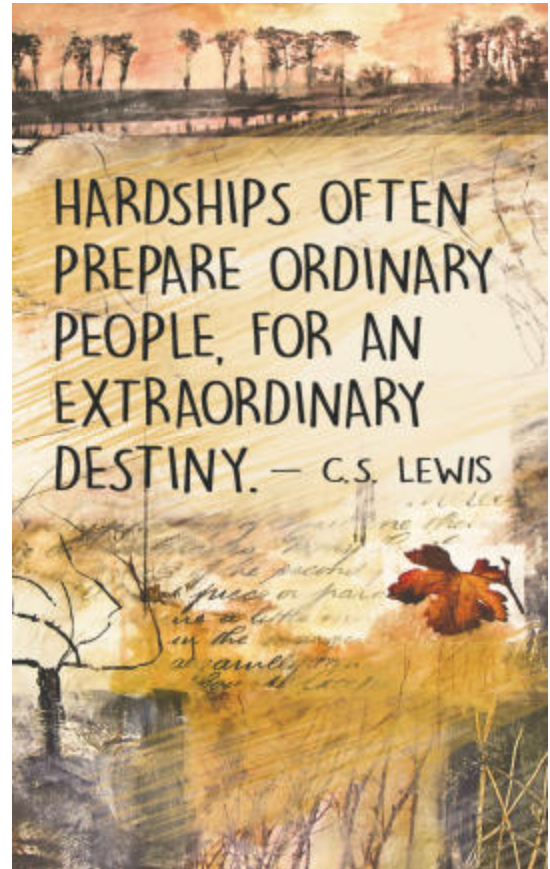
