

For the haughty have risen up against me, the ruthless seek my life; they set not God before their eyes. Behold, God is my helper; the Lord sustains my life. Freely will I offer you sacrifice; I will praise your name, O LORD, for its goodness."* ~ Psalm 54

The Lord upholds my life!!!

October 3rd is Pro-Life Sunday and October is Pro-Life Month Please keep the unborn and their mothers in your prayers. In the words of St. John Paul II, *"Give us the grace, when the sacredness of life before birth is attacked, to stand up and proclaim that no one ever has the authority to destroy unborn life."*

Senator John C. Calhoun of South Carolina Calhoun gave a speech on the Senate floor in 1837 that proved to be an inflection point in American history. Prior to his speech, the typical slave owner in the south considered slavery a necessary evil that sustained the southern economy. Thomas Jefferson, when speaking of slavery, said, *"We have the wolf by the ear, and we can neither hold him, nor safely let him go. Justice is in one scale, and self-preservation in the other."* Most southerners assumed that slavery would someday disappear from our country.



Calhoun proclaimed in his speech, *"I hold that in the present state of civilization, where two races of different origin, and distinguished by color, and other physical differences, as well as intellectual, are brought together, the relation now existing in the slaveholding States between the two, is, instead of an evil, a good, a positive good."* The attitude among southerners had now changed dramatically and radically. They now considered slavery a positive good instead of a necessary evil and, because of this attitude, it took the civil war to eradicate slavery from our nation.

The Pro-abortion movement has now made a similar move that Calhoun made in 1837. They now consider abortion a positive good rather than, in the historical (1990's) words of both President Clinton and Hillary Clinton, something that should be *"safe, legal and rare."*

The state of New York passed the so-called Reproductive Health Act a few years ago. It allows abortion up to the point of birth. It modified the state penal code to eliminate references to an aborted child or the death of the unborn. It redefines a human person to *"a human being who has been born and is alive"*. In effect, the unborn child, legally, is no longer a human person and receives no protection under the law.

Abortionists are no longer required to care for a baby born during the abortion. The law repeals section 4164 of the New York public health code that held that a baby born alive during was immediately protected by New York's state law and would have to be cared for as any baby has to be cared for. ***This is legalized infanticide.***

Similar laws have been passed in the state of Illinois and signed into law by Gov. Pritzker. House Bill 2467 & Senate Bill 1594 repealed the Illinois Parental Notification of Abortion Act. House Bill 2495 & Senate Bill 1942 repealed the state ban on partial-birth abortions, defined abortion as a fundamental right, removed abortion clinics from regulations for serious medical procedures and removed the requirement that only doctors can perform abortions.

One of the tragedies of these laws is that pro-abortion activists and politicians no longer settle for abortion being *"safe, legal and rare"* as the Clintons did in the 1990's. Hillary Clinton now defends partial-birth abortion if the unborn child is disabled. Our laws have been changed to systematically remove any legal recognition that an unborn child could be worthy of protection or concern.

Pope Francis recently spoke to journalists concerning abortion on his return flight from Slovakia. He said about abortion, *"it's more than a problem, it's homicide, whoever has an abortion, kills. No mincing words. . . . That is why the Church is so harsh on this issue, because if it accepts this, it is as if it accepts daily murder."*

We are called to follow after our Lord Jesus and proclaim His gospel to all people. We are not called to proclaim our own gospel but, rather, to proclaim the Lord's gospel which is the Gospel of Life. We are duty-bound as faithful Catholics, as disciples of the Lord of Life, to boldly proclaim the Gospel of Life and to defend the sanctity of all human life with our words, our deeds, our prayers and our votes.

Simon and Andrew, James and John, the sons of Zebedee, dropped everything to follow after the Lord. The disciples and apostles left the upper room, went out into a hostile world, faced persecution and boldly proclaimed the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all the world.

We are the disciples of the 21st century. The Church, both the laity and the ordained, has gone out into the world boldly proclaiming the gospel of life for over two-thousand years. How can we, in good conscious, do less than our mothers and fathers in the faith?


