St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry - July Update

Two-hundred eighty-three individuals, including 49 children from 81 families, were assisted in July. This is a small increase in client numbers from previous months. New clients again are being served.

Condensed soup (not Chunky or Progresso), pasta sides, crackers (not Saltines), corn muffins, and bagged potatoes (5# bags, if possible).

One additional volunteer is needed from 10:30 am to 1:00 pm on Thursdays to help in the back room.

A gracious “thank-you” to all the volunteers committed to serve the clients. The client numbers should begin to grow, as calls are being received from clients who have not been to the pantry for quite a while.

Volunteers will continue to wear masks and serve the clients as a drive through. If a volunteer does not feel well due to a cold, etc., please do not come in, as some of the volunteers have family members with health issues. Thank you.
