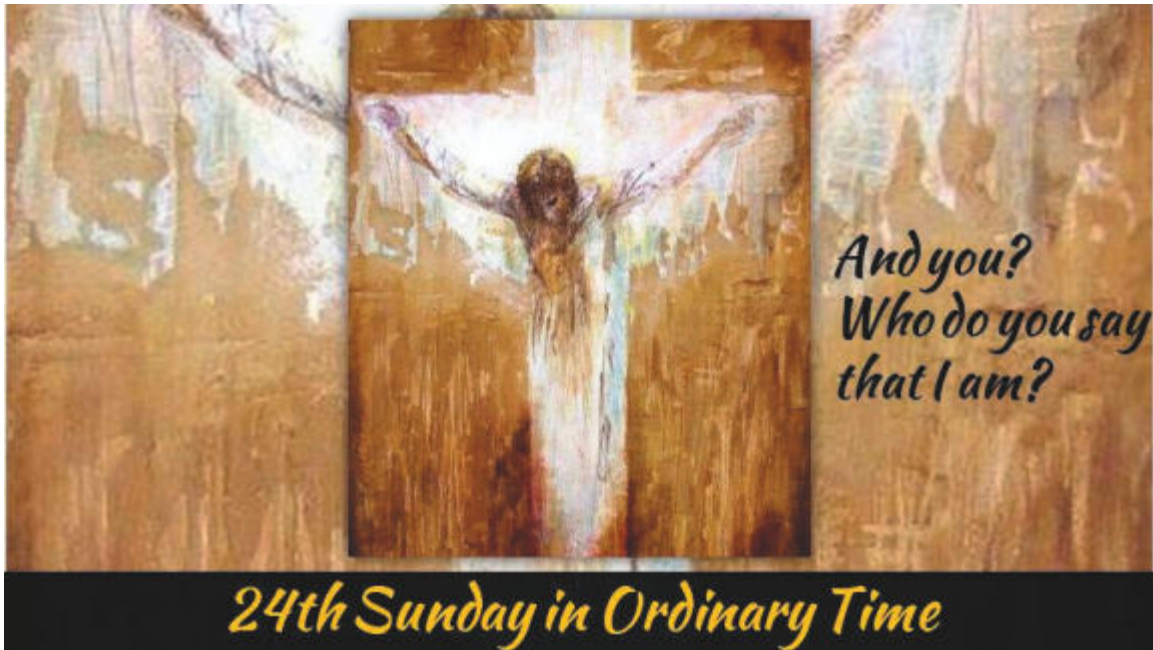

CoVID Measures in Place NEW

- As you may know, the Racine City Council recently approved an ordinance to once again require face coverings for all people in public indoor spaces in the City of Racine, regardless of vaccination status. The ordinance goes into effect on September 4. In accordance with the mandate, masks will be required at all Masses, unless a medical condition prevents a person from using one. We will continue to follow local guidance, and we thank you for your patience and cooperation.
- We are going to keep social distancing measures by still using every other pew (we really do not need all the pews to assume our normal Mass attendance) and by still having the ministers distribute communion in the pews.
- We will keep a basket at the back of the church for the collection.
- In addition to the weekly Friday cleaning, we will clean and disinfect the church between the 8 AM and 10 AM Masses on Sunday.
- We will continue live-streaming all our Weekday Masses and the 10 AM on Sunday on Facebook Live, YouTube and on our website.

Family Faith Formation Program

We call it our flagship ministry, and it is based on four principles:

- (1) it happens on Sunday—so connected to the community's Eucharist; (2) it is free (since why should parishioners who are already participating in the stewardship of the parish pay extra for the parish to form them and their children?); (3) it forms not only the students but also their parents—opening the adult formation component to any adult in the parish; (4) we curate or produce great quality materials.

The catechists gathered for the first time this past Sunday, and students and their families will gather for the first time on Sunday, September 19. The adult first session will be a talk by Fr.
