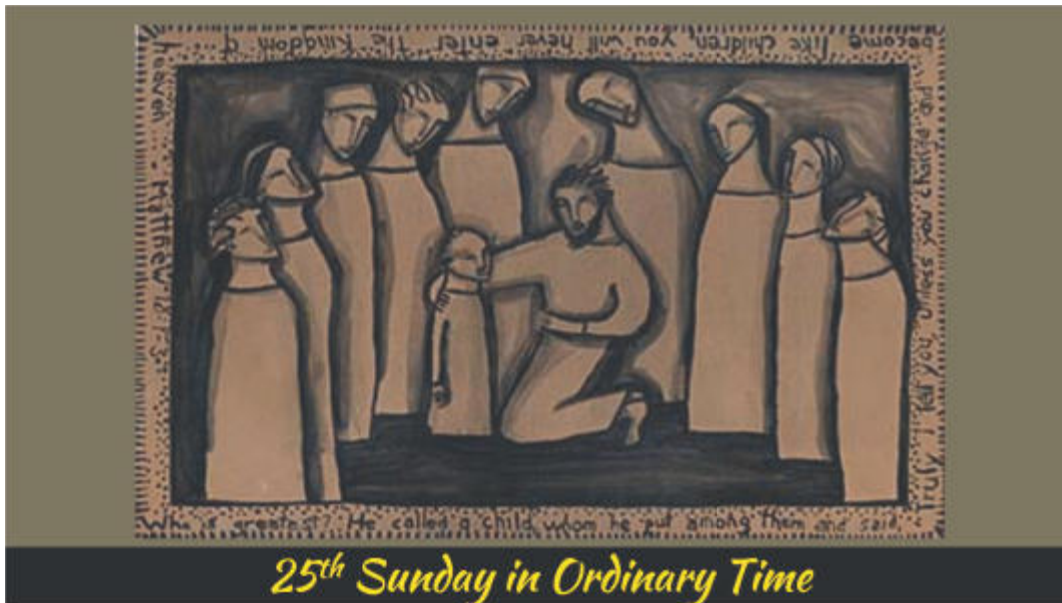

CoVID Measures in Place

- As you may know, the Racine City Council recently [approved an ordinance](#) to once again require face coverings for all people in public indoor spaces in the City of Racine, regardless of vaccination status. The ordinance went into effect on September 4. In accordance with the mandate, masks will be required at all Masses, unless a medical condition prevents a person from using one. We will continue to follow local guidance, and we thank you for your patience and cooperation.
- We are going to keep social distancing measures by still using every other pew (we really do not need all the pews to assume our normal Mass attendance) and by still having the ministers distribute communion in the pews.
- We will keep a basket at the back of the church for the collection.
- In addition to the weekly Friday cleaning, we will clean and disinfect the church between the 8 AM and 10 AM Masses on Sunday.
- We will continue live-streaming all our Weekday Masses and the 10 AM on Sunday on Facebook Live, YouTube and on our website.

Capital Campaign Kick-Off



This weekend is the kick-off weekend for the Love One Another Capital Campaign. We are very encouraged by the amazingly generous response of the parishioners of Sacred Heart. This is a five-year campaign, and our goal is \$700,000 (1.4 times our ordinary annual income.) Sixty percent of the proceeds stay at the parish for four different projects (which were highlighted in the bulletin over the past weeks) and 40% goes to the Archdiocese for formation, Catholic Schools, social ministries, etc. If you want to discuss the campaign personally with Fr.
