***St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry***

### CoVID Measures in Place

- As you may know, the Racine City Council approved an ordinance to once again require face coverings for all people in public indoor spaces in the City of Racine, regardless of vaccination status. The ordinance went into effect on September 4. In accordance with the mandate, masks are required at all Masses, unless a medical condition prevents a person from using one. We will continue to follow local guidance, and we thank you for your patience and cooperation.
- We are going to keep social distancing measures by still using every other pew (we really do not need all the pews to assume our normal Mass attendance) and by having the ministers distribute communion in the pews.
- We will keep a basket at the back of the church for the collection.
- In addition to the weekly Friday cleaning, we will clean and disinfect the church between the 8 AM and 10 AM Masses on Sunday.
- We will continue live-streaming all our Weekday Masses and the 10 AM on Sunday on Facebook Live, YouTube and on our website.
