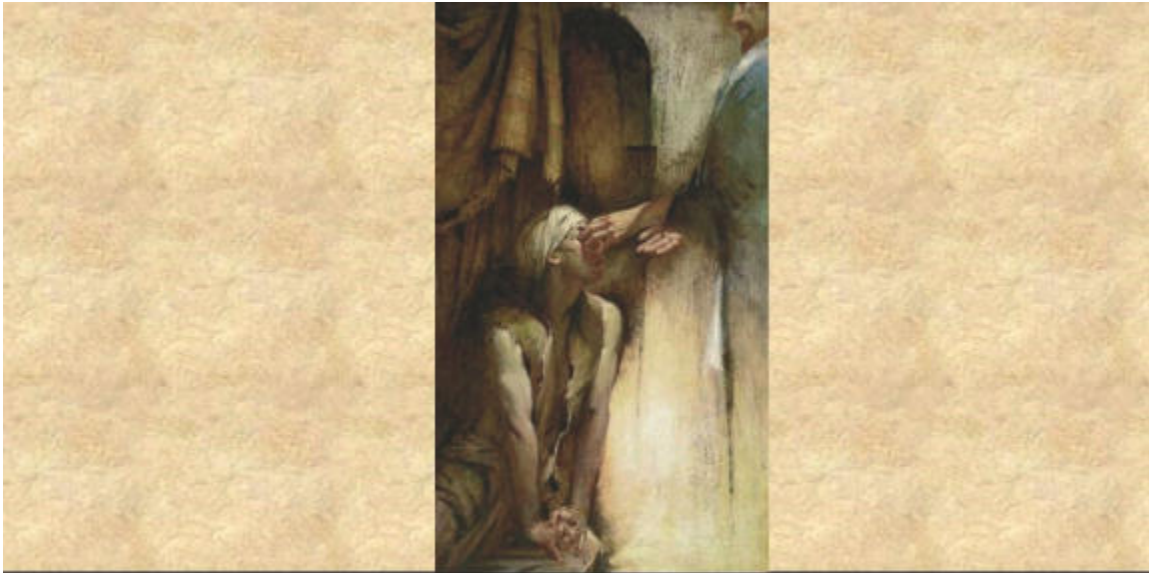

**Parish Anniversary Weekend on October 30 & 31**

For the last few years we have celebrated the Parish Anniversary on the last weekend in October, which marks the weekend in 1916 when the parish was legally incorporated. Still mindful of necessary CoVID precautions, we will have Fellowship after all the weekend Masses (instead of our one large traditional brunch at 10 AM.)

There will be a wine and cheese social after the 4:30 PM Mass and a more brunch-type fellowship after the Masses on Sunday. We will have a Saturday Morning of Service on October 30 and some other activities. If you want to sign up for helping us with the celebration, or for the Morning of Service, please contact the parish office.

**Mass Intentions 2022**

The Mass Intention Book is now open for the year 2022. Please call or email the parish office, or place your Mass request in an envelope marked "Parish Office," and drop it in the collection basket. We ask that you include your phone number.

Be mindful that we try to balance weekend and weekday Masses, as weekend Masses are most in demand. By Canon Law, one of the weekend Masses has the intention set for the Living and Deceased Members of Sacred Heart (the *pro-populo* Mass). Therefore, we limit initial requests to selecting only two weekend Masses and five weekday Masses per person making the request. Once there has been a reasonable opportunity for everyone, if there are Masses without an intention, it will be announced in the bulletin. The stipend in the Archdiocese is \$10.

### Beginning on November 2 (All Souls Day) Masses on Tuesday will be at 6:00 PM

Before the pandemic, our most attended weekday Mass was Tuesday evening. Beginning with the celebration of All Souls, November 2, Mass on Tuesday will be at 6:00 PM. We will continue live-streaming this Mass.

At the Mass for All Souls, we remember All the Faithful Departed; and at Sacred Heart, we have a special ritual to commemorate those parishioners who have died during the year.

### Love One Another Campaign Update

Last week we made the goal for the Love One Another Capital Campaign, so congratulations to all of us! We will now continue our efforts knowing that any pledges from now on will be distributed 80% for the parish and 20% for the Archdiocese. If we surpass \$875,000, 100% of the pledge funds after that would stay with Sacred Heart.



As you know, our parish case consists of starting a fund for major repairs, upgrading the church itself, remodeling the basement for a Faith Formation space, and creating an endowment-type fund for those most in need. Any pledge, big or small, helps.

We want to know your opinion, so during the Fellowship after Mass on our Parish Anniversary Weekend, we will facilitate a brainstorm process on how to upgrade our church space.

### CoVID Measures in Place

- On September 4, 2021, the Racine City Council approved an ordinance that requires face coverings for all people in public indoor spaces in the City of Racine, regardless of vaccination status. In accordance with the mandate, masks will be required at all Masses, unless a medical condition prevents a person from using one. We will continue to follow local guidance, and we thank you for your patience and cooperation.
  - Social distancing measures will continue by using every other pew and by still having the ministers distribute communion in the pews.
  - A basket is at the back of the church for the collection.
  - Besides the usual Friday cleaning, the church will be cleaned and disinfected between the 8 AM and 10 AM Masses on Sunday.

### Did you Know? The Baptistry at Sacred Heart

Using architecture to make a great liturgical point, the baptismal font at Sacred Heart is located at the entrance of the church—as baptism is the entrance into the community of the Catholic Church for the baptized. The Catholic Church recognizes the validity of any Christian baptism as long as water and the Trinitarian formula are used. This is why a Lutheran, Methodist, or a Baptist, just to give some examples, are not baptized again when fully received in the Catholic Church.
