"Continuing Our Parish COVID Protocols"

As we continue to learn to live with COVID-19 in our midst, and adjust to the changing variants, I am thankful for our pastors and parish leaders and their diligence in continuing the protocols already in place to help people feel safe while attending Mass. The protocols may include clearly designated areas for mask wearing and social distancing, as well as providing hand sanitizer and extra cleaning.

When possible, those who hold large parish meetings where social distancing options are not available, may consider changing to virtual attendance or postponing for now.

While there has been no outbreak of COVID-19 from Mass attendance, I'd like to encourage people to exercise personal responsibility. <u>Those who feel sick, or who are especially</u> <u>at risk of health complications, should stay</u> <u>home and watch Sunday worship on the</u> <u>many Masses broadcast on TV and live-</u> <u>streamed on social media until they feel</u> <u>comfortable returning to in-person Mass.</u> In those situations, or for those taking care of someone who is sick, Sunday Mass attendance is excused.

Our Sunday worship is a joyful obligation. It is a witness to God as the priority in our lives. By remaining diligent in these ways, we help ensure our parishioners feel safe attending Mass and can continue experiencing the connectedness of our parish communities, which is such a vital part of our lives.

#### SUNDAY MEDITATION

Today's Gospel continues last week's account of Jesus coming to His hometown of Nazareth and His reading and teaching in Nazareth's synagogue on the Sabbath. Last week we heard Jesus as He read a passage from the prophet Isaiah, which told of the Savior Messiah whom God promised would someday bring healing, restoration and salvation to the people of Israel. After reading that passage, Jesus proclaimed that this passage was fulfilled in their hearing. Jesus was announcing Himself as the long-promised Messiah. Today we heard how His hometown people reacted.

Alas, the majority of people gathered there that day were unable to see that Jesus was the longawaited Messiah. They seemed blinded by knowing that Jesus grew up humbly among them as the son of Joseph, the carpenter. They apparently imagined that the Messiah was supposed to be someone like the great King David, who slew Goliath, conquered oppressors and built up the nation of Israel. Jesus certainly did not fit that mold. And so, many rejected Jesus and His Divine message of salvation.

We can be too hasty in criticizing the people of Nazareth and avoid examining ourselves. They did have certain unmet expectations. But how often do we think things should unfold and happen in our lives in a certain time and fashion? And then when our expectations are not met in a timely and complete manner, we suffer frustration, and we may be tempted to turn away from God because of our frustration.

It is good for our hearts to consider that God indeed hears and responds to our prayers, but He answers in His time and in a way that is ultimately best for us. It is a deep wisdom to let Him prune our desires and let Him help us grow well.

#### CANDLEMAS AND THE BLESSING OF THROATS

**Feb. 2** is Candlemas, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord Jesus in the Jerusalem Temple 40 days after His birth on Christmas. On this day candles are traditionally blessed for use at home, remembering Simeon's prophetic words to Mary and Joseph that Jesus would be a light to the Gentiles. We hope to have boxes of blessed pairs of candles available at the next weekend's Masses. Because they are *blessed* objects, we may *not* sell them. **No** donation is required, but you are entirely free to help cover their cost.

**ST. BLAISE'S** feast day is the next day, Feb. 3rd. This day is marked each year by a simple and popular sacramental, the blessing of throats, invoking the intercession of St. Blaise against every disease of the throat <u>and every other illness</u>. We will have the blessing of throats at next Sunday's (and Saturday evening's) Masses.
